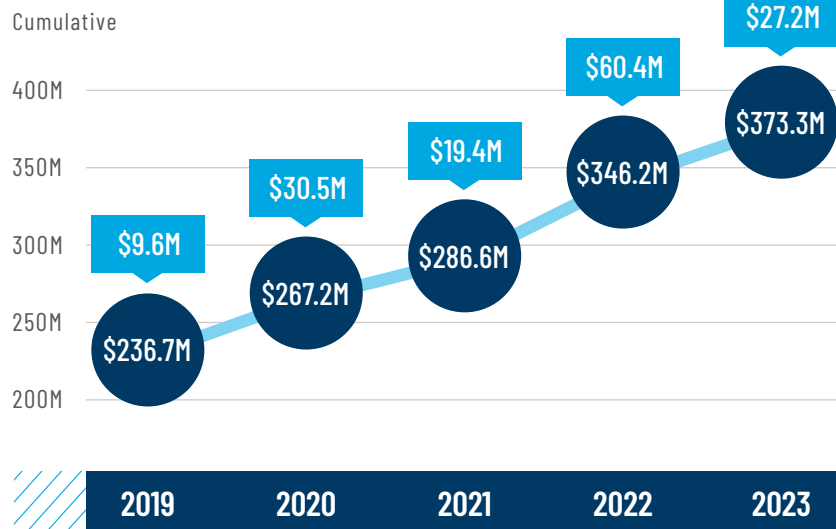

TRUST FUND FOR COUNTER-TERRORISM SINCE 2009 AND OTHER FUNDS (USD MILLION)

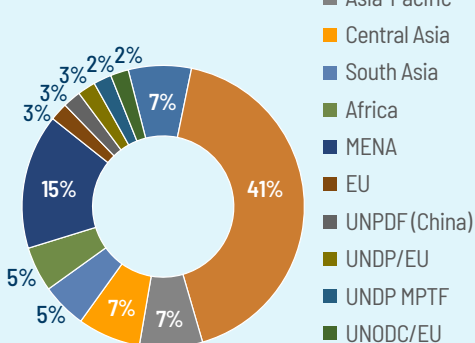

The United Nations held its Third Counter-Terrorism Week in New York from 19 – 23 June, which included the Third High-Level Conference of Heads of Counter-Terrorism Agencies of Member States, the adoption by consensus of the eight review of the UN Global Counter-Terrorism Strategy, and 40 side events on counter-terrorism and the prevention and countering of violent extremism, including the planting of the UN Victims of Terrorism Solidarity Tree.

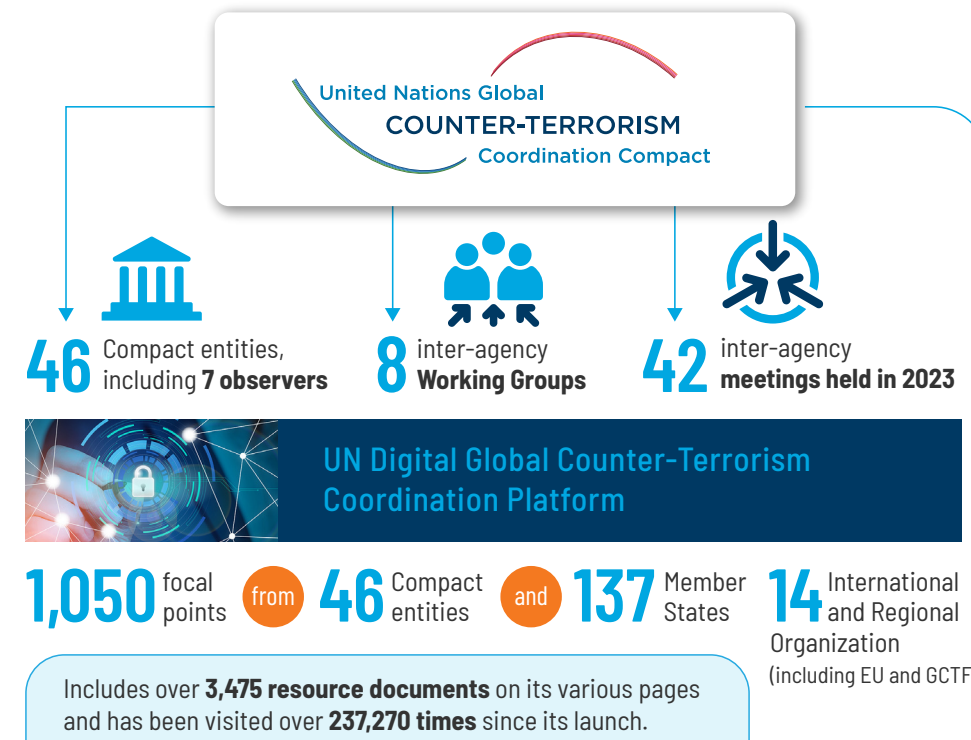
