

## 2021-2022 United Nations Multi-Year Appeal for Counter-Terrorism



The **United Nations Multi-Year Appeal for Counter-Terrorism** is a tool for coordinating United Nations resource mobilization efforts to secure sustainable and predictable funding to effectively respond to the complex and continually evolving threat of terrorism and violent extremism.

The **2021-2022 Multi-Year Appeal** consolidates initiatives from CTED, IMO, INTERPOL, IOM, OHCHR, UNDP, UNICEF, UNICRI, UNOCT, UNODC, UNRCCA and UN Women across the four Pillars of the United Nations Global Counter-Terrorism Strategy (GCTS).

The Multi-Year Appeal **requests \$179 million for 52 projects and programmes at the global, regional, and national levels** to support Member States' counter-terrorism priorities with due attention to mainstreaming human rights and gender into project proposals.

Built as an interactive dashboard, the Appeal website allows Member States, potential donors and other UN entities and stakeholders to browse project proposals per geographical location (region and country), by entity and across all four Pillars of the GCTS.

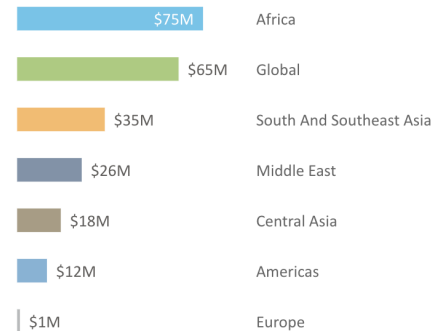
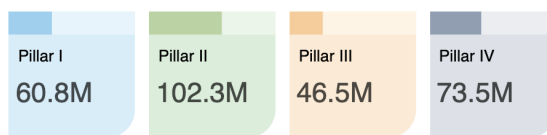
