Side events

The United Nations Office of Counter-Terrorism (UNOCT) is pleased to announce it will facilitate a series of side events on the margins of the High-Level Conference on Human Rights, Civil Society, and Counter-Terrorism in Málaga, Spain. The side events will take place on **9 May 2022** in a **hybrid format** and will provide an opportunity for discussion and knowledge exchange by diverse stakeholders on how to effectively embed human rights and the rule of law into the international community's response to terrorism.

To launch the side events, the Kingdom of Spain will host a **workshop** on Enhancing Civil Society Organizations' Leadership and Promotion and Protection of Human Rights in Counter-Terrorism. In

addition, there will be **six side events**, each focusing on a specific theme on emerging and priority topics in CT and P/CVE. Side events will involve multi-stakeholder discussions and are expected to generate rich exchanges and innovative recommendations. The side events are co-organized by UNOCT, a Member State sponsor, and a Civil Society Organization. The involvement of additional partners, including other UN entities, interregional organizations, NGOs, academia, think tanks, and the private sector, is also encouraged.
