KEY ISSUES RAISED BY HEADS OF ENTITIES

- <u>Secretary-General Guterres</u> urged to support victims and survivors of terrorism by amplifying their voices, protecting their rights, and seeking justice
- <u>USG Voronkov</u> stressed the need of common efforts towards reinforcing the global nuclear security architecture and the universalization and implementation of ICSANT
- USG Waly underlined that UNODC's newly launched global programme on preventing and countering terrorism takes a people-centered approach with the perspectives of the victims at its core
- Acting ED Chen emphasized that a comprehensive, coordinated, "All-of-UN" approach remains crucial to developing and implementing effective counterterrorism measures
- Special Adviser Ritscher reiterated UNITAD's commitment to ensure justice is rendered to Yazidi victims and survivors of ISIL crimes
- <u>DUSG Gregorian</u> highlighted that the UN field presences have strengthened the delivery of tailored and effective technical assistance and capacity-building support to Member States
