- [USG Voronkov](#) stressed that the Global Counter-Terrorism Coordination Compact and its Border Management Working Group remain committed to supporting Central Asian States to strengthen their border control capacities and cross-border cooperation
- [CTED AED Chen](#) noted the Security Council's call on States to develop and implement comprehensive and tailored prosecution, rehabilitation and reintegration strategies
- [ED Waly](#) emphasized it is imperative that the UN system works together to leverage the tools at our disposal to build resilience to terrorism
- [INTERPOL ED Oberoi](#) called for continued and enhanced international cooperation to counter the use of UAS for terrorist purposes




