



EU-UN Global Terrorism Threats Facility

A new facility for UN technical assistance, in cooperation with the European Union, to provide rapid and flexible support to Member States facing an urgent or evolving terrorist threat or situation. It seeks to help Member States increase their capacities to detect, prevent, counter, respond to and investigate evolving terrorist threats, while ensuring the respect for international law, including human rights and the rule of law.

HOW IT WORKS

The facility will be delivered according to two principles:

- 1. to offer **rapid** assistance in emergency situations and/or threats and
- 2. to offer **complementary** to other UN-related support.

Member States can request a new or additional assistance from the facility with a view to addressing the security, counterterrorism, national defence, through to border law enforcement of their own requests.

HOW IT WORKS IN PRACTICE

The facility will be delivered through three types of activities:

- 1. **Technical assistance** which proceeds through the deployment of experts to identify and help improve the number of threats cases, vulnerability, detection and response.
- 2. **Training activities or workshops** which could be developed with domestic police, law enforcement agencies or other stakeholders, where and
- 3. **Online provision of legal and other support.**
