The Permanent Mission of Chile to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General to the United Nations and has the honour to refer to *Note Verbale* N° 38/2025 of 1 April 2025 regarding Chile's forthcoming submission before the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf concerning information on the limits of its continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles, in accordance with Article 76, paragraph 8, of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS).

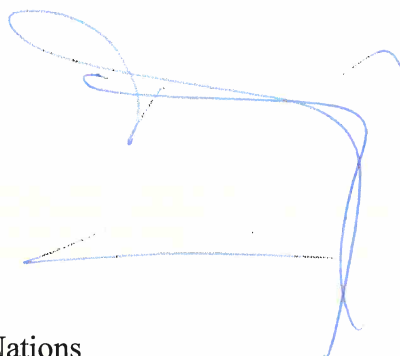
The Republic of Chile wishes to inform the Secretary-General that the data-processing and drafting phase of its third partial submission has been concluded, and has the honour to hereby submit to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf information on the limits of Chile's continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles from the baselines from which the breadth of its territorial sea is measured in respect to the Continental Shelf of the Juan Fernández Archipelago region.

This submission includes supporting scientific and technical data in accordance with Annex III of the Rules of Procedure of the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf (CLCS/40/Rev.2). The Republic of Chile respectfully requests that the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf consider the information submitted.

The Permanent Mission of Chile to the United Nations kindly requests that this *Note Verbale* be circulated to all Member States and published on the website of the Division for Ocean Affairs and the Law of the Sea, in conformity with SPLOS/183, paragraph 1 (d).

The Permanent Mission of Chile to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretary-General of the United Nations the assurances of its highest considerations.
