**United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea  
concluded at Montego Bay, Jamaica  
on 10 December 1982**

Receipt of two addenda to the executive summary of the partial revised Submission  
made by the Russian Federation to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf  
in respect of the Arctic Ocean

The Secretary-General of the United Nations communicates the following:

On 3 August 2015, the Russian Federation submitted to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf, in accordance with article 76, paragraph 8, of the Convention, and with reference to its Submission of 20 December 2001, information on the limits of the continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles from the baselines from which the breadth of its territorial sea is measured in respect of the Arctic Ocean.

On 31 March 2021, the Russian Federation submitted two addenda to the executive summary of the partial revised Submission in respect of the Arctic Ocean. The two addenda, concern: (i) Gakkel Ridge, Nansen and Amundsen Basins, and (ii) Lomonosov Ridge, Alpha Ridge, Mendeleev Rise, Amundsen and Makarov Basins, and the Canadian Basin, respectively.

In accordance with the rules of procedure of the Commission, the present communication is being circulated to all Member States of the United Nations, as well as States Parties to the Convention, in order to make public the addenda to the executive summary of the partial revised Submission in respect of the Arctic Ocean, including all illustrative maps and coordinates contained therein.
