I wish to inform you that the result of the vote conducted on Tuesday, 25 August 2020, for the remaining seat on the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea, was that no candidate obtained the required majority of votes. The details of the result can be found in Annex A.

Consequently, there still remains one seat to be filled from among the candidates from the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States. The thirtieth Meeting of States Parties will hold the third round of balloting tomorrow, Wednesday, 26 August 2020, from 10.00 a.m., in the General Assembly Hall.

In accordance with the decision adopted on 24 August 2020, rule 66 of the Rules of Procedure for Meetings of States Parties (SPLOS/2/Rev.5) will apply. The third round of balloting (second restricted ballot) will be restricted to the two candidates from the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States who were not elected but obtained the greatest number of votes in the previous ballot, namely Ms. Kathy-Ann Brown (Jamaica) and Mr. Rodrigo Fernandes More (Brazil).

Information on the conduct of the election is enclosed in Annex B. Please note that a fourth round of balloting may be required tomorrow. Information on this will be provided tomorrow at the start of the meeting.

I thank the tellers and the staff of the United Nations Secretariat for their assistance in the second round of the election held today.

1. There remains one seat to be filled from among the candidates from the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States.

## Candidates

2. In accordance with rule 66 of the Rules of Procedure for Meetings of States Parties (SPLOS/2/Rev.5), this third round of balloting will be restricted to the two candidates from among the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States who were not elected but obtained the greatest number of votes in the previous ballot, namely Ms. Kathy-Ann Brown (Jamaica) and Mr. Rodrigo Fernandes More (Brazil).

## Required majority

3. The candidate who obtains the largest number of votes and a two-thirds majority of the States Parties present and voting shall be declared elected, provided that such majority includes a majority of the States Parties.

## Conduct of the election
