DECISIONS

1991/273. Adoption of the agenda of the second regular session of 1991 and other organizational matters

1. At its 16th plenary meeting, on 3 July 1991, the Economic and Social Council adopted the agenda of its second regular session of 1991¹⁵¹ and approved the organization of work for the session.¹⁵²

2. At its 18th plenary meeting, on 8 July 1991, the Council approved the requests made by non-governmental organizations to be heard by the Council at its second regular session of 1991.¹⁵³

3. At its 25th plenary meeting, on 15 July 1991, the Council decided to include in its agenda an item entitled "Elections".¹⁵⁴

1991/274. Convening of an international conference on development financing

At its 31st plenary meeting, on 26 July 1991, the Economic and Social Council decided:

(a) To take note of the proposal made by the Secretary-General in his statement at the opening of the second regular session of 1991 of the Council, on 3 July, that consideration be given to the convening of an international conference on development financing;¹⁵⁵

(b) To refer the matter to the General Assembly at its forty-sixth session for further consideration.

1991/275. Report of the Committee for Development Planning

At its 31st plenary meeting, on 26 July 1991, the Economic and Social Council:

(a) Took note of the report of the Committee for Development Planning on its twenty-seventh session;¹⁵⁶

(b) Decided that further consideration of chapter V of the report should be carried out by the General Assembly at its forty-sixth session, taking into account the views expressed at the second regular session of 1991 of the Council;

(c) Invited interested Governments, with technical advice from appropriate United Nations bodies, if necessary, to make their comments available to the General Assembly at its forty-sixth session.
