

Key policy issues crucial to reduce gender inequality, but many not mentioned in VNRs





Examples of actions implemented by countries to address gender inequality, as mentioned in their VNRs

TIMOR-LESTE

The "100 percent Hau Prontu" initiative (100% I'm ready), is a Government-NGO partnership which encourages and prepares women for leadership, under the slogan 'Feto Forte, Nasaun Forte', Strong Women, Strong Nation.

SOUTH AFRICA

The prevalence of marriage by girls under 15 decreased significantly between 2010 and 2014, with only seven recorded early marriages in 2014. This may indicate that the legislative frameworks that have been put in place, such as the Recognition of Customary Marriages Act, deter early marriage.

LIECHTENSTEIN

A "day care financing" working group has been set up to develop performance-based financing of day care centres, taking into account the various forms of childcare and according to the principle of equal treatment of all providers.
