

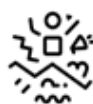

A discussion on inclusive Comprehensive Sexuality Education for youth with a disability

There are 1 billion people with disabilities living in the world today. Youth with a disability still face barriers to meaningfully participate in society and education settings, as as many as 33 million children with a disability are out of school. As a result, youth with a disability lack adequate information and education on their lives, bodily autonomy, and sexuality.

In this reality, how can Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) be used to provide youth with a disability with adequate information and how can it cater to their realities?

Along with keynote speakers, there will be a discussion amongst disability expert panelists and governments. The audience will be invited to reflect on the need for CSE & to learn from country examples. The event will showcase initiatives and programmes that highlight common and tailored approaches that enable comprehensive sexuality education to be inclusive of people with a disability.
