Biographies of experts



Ayaga A. Bawah is Director of Regional Institute for Population Studies, University of Ghana, and Research Affiliate of the Population Studies Center, University of Pennsylvania. He has expertise in population and health research, including reproductive health and family planning, and maternal and child health. He is a member of Ghana's Food and Drugs Authority's Technical Advisory Committee on Clinical Trials (TAC-CT), member of the International Union for the Scientific Study of Population, Union for African Population Studies, and the Population Association of America. He has previously served as Assistant Professor at Columbia University's Mailman School of Public Health, New York.



Piedad Urdinola Contreras is the General Director of the National Administrative Department of Statistics – DANE, Colombia's National Statistics Office. She is an expert in quantitative demography with research focus on Latin America. Her research interests include mortality and human health, adolescent fertility, and intergenerational transfers. She was an associate professor at the Department of Statistics of the Universidad Nacional for 16 years. She has also served as Director of the Demographic and Epidemiological Observatory of the Andean Area (ODEAN), and as co-founder and co-director of the Human Mortality Database of Latin America.



Elżbieta Gołata is Professor of Economics and Vice-Rector for Research and International Relations at the Poznań University of Economics and Business. She is President of the Committee on Demographic Studies of the Polish Academy of Sciences since 2020. She serves on various councils and committees, including on the Scientific Statistical Council appointed by the President of the Central Statistical Office of Poland, and the Polish Statistical Association. Her research interests include population ageing, labour markets, social statistics, statistics for small areas, and quality assessment of statistical data, including population census.



Mohammad Mainul Islam is a professor, Department of Population Sciences of the University of Dhaka, Bangladesh. He serves on the Population Expert Group/Committee in the Ministry of Planning in Bangladesh since November 2017. He is an Associate Editor of the Journal of Population and Development. His research focuses on reproductive health, population and development, global health, population and health policies and programs in Bangladesh, child and youth population, and social demography. He has previously served on several national technical committees and projects, including the Task Team of Action Report on Population and Development of Bangladesh, the Bangladesh Population and Housing Census-2021 Project, and the project on Strengthening Environment, Climate Change, and Disaster Statistics.
