Explanation of position after the adoption of the Declaration on the occasion of the thirtieth anniversary of the International Conference on population and Development

## Madam Chair,

my delegation welcomes the adoption of the political declaration in anticipation of the thirtieth anniversary of the International Conference on Population and Development Programme of Action. We also express our appreciation for the chair's leadership in guiding us to a successful conference.

We commend the Chair and Bureau for their dedication to accommodating our concerns. This approach has facilitated a more balanced outcome that duly considers the diverse positions and priorities of the states.
