- Argentina, Colombia, Chile and Perú have received large flows from neighboring countries.
- Mexico had more than I million migrants, mainly from US (64%)

- In 2023: more than 7 million Venezuelans living abroad.



FUTURE MIGRATION SCENARIOS

- I. The continent will remain highly mobile, in spite of the demographic convergence in the region.
- 2. US as a magnet for labor migration.
- 3. Establishment of large migrant communities across countries that keep family and social ties.
- 4. Constant (although fluctuating) return migration.
- 5. Through Central America and Mexico: in transit migration and extra-continental flows (from Africa, Eastern Europe, Asia)
- 6. Climate change, political instability and violence as drivers of migration in the short and medium term.
- 7. Heterogenous profile of migration flows: children, family units, vulnerable populations.
