is the Assistant Director-General for Health Systems and Services at the World Health Organization (WHO). Prior to joining WHO, she was the Assistant Director of the Pan American Health Organization. A national of Dominica, Dr Etienne began her career as a medical officer at the Princess Margaret Hospital in her country, where she eventually became the Chief Medical Officer. Other high-level posts she has held include the Coordinator of Dominica's National AIDS Programme, Disaster Coordinator for the Ministry of Health of Dominica, Chairperson for the National Advisory Council for HIV/AIDS and the Director of Primary Health Care for Dominica. Dr Etienne received her MBBS degree from the University of the West Indies, Jamaica, and her M.Sc. degree in community health in developing countries from the University of London.
