Mr. Barry Popkin

is the Carla Smith Chamblee Distinguished Professor of Global Nutrition at the University of North Carolina –Chapel Hill (UNC-CH). He directs the UNC-CH's Interdisciplinary Center for Obesity. He has developed longitudinal multilevel studies in many countries to study diet, physical activity, nutritional status and health changes. More recently he developed the concept of the nutrition transition and directs detailed longitudinal studies that examine the nutrition transition in China, Russia and the United States. He also has initiated a study in the Philippines and is involved in research in Brazil, Mexico, South Africa, the United Arab Emirates, and several other countries. Mr. Popkin is Chair of the Nutrition Transition Committee for the International Union for the Nutritional Sciences. He has published more than 290 journal articles in addition to numerous book chapters. He is author of the book "The World Is Fat".
