International migrants by age - methodology

- Estimates for all countries with a total population of 100,000 or more (196 countries)
- Selection of source tables (censuses, registers, administrative sources)
- Age standardization
 - Interpolation, Extrapolation, etc.
- Period estimates (1990 / 2000 / 2010)
 - Countries with data for 2 or 3 periods
 - Countries with data available for only 1 time period
 - Countries with no empirical data available

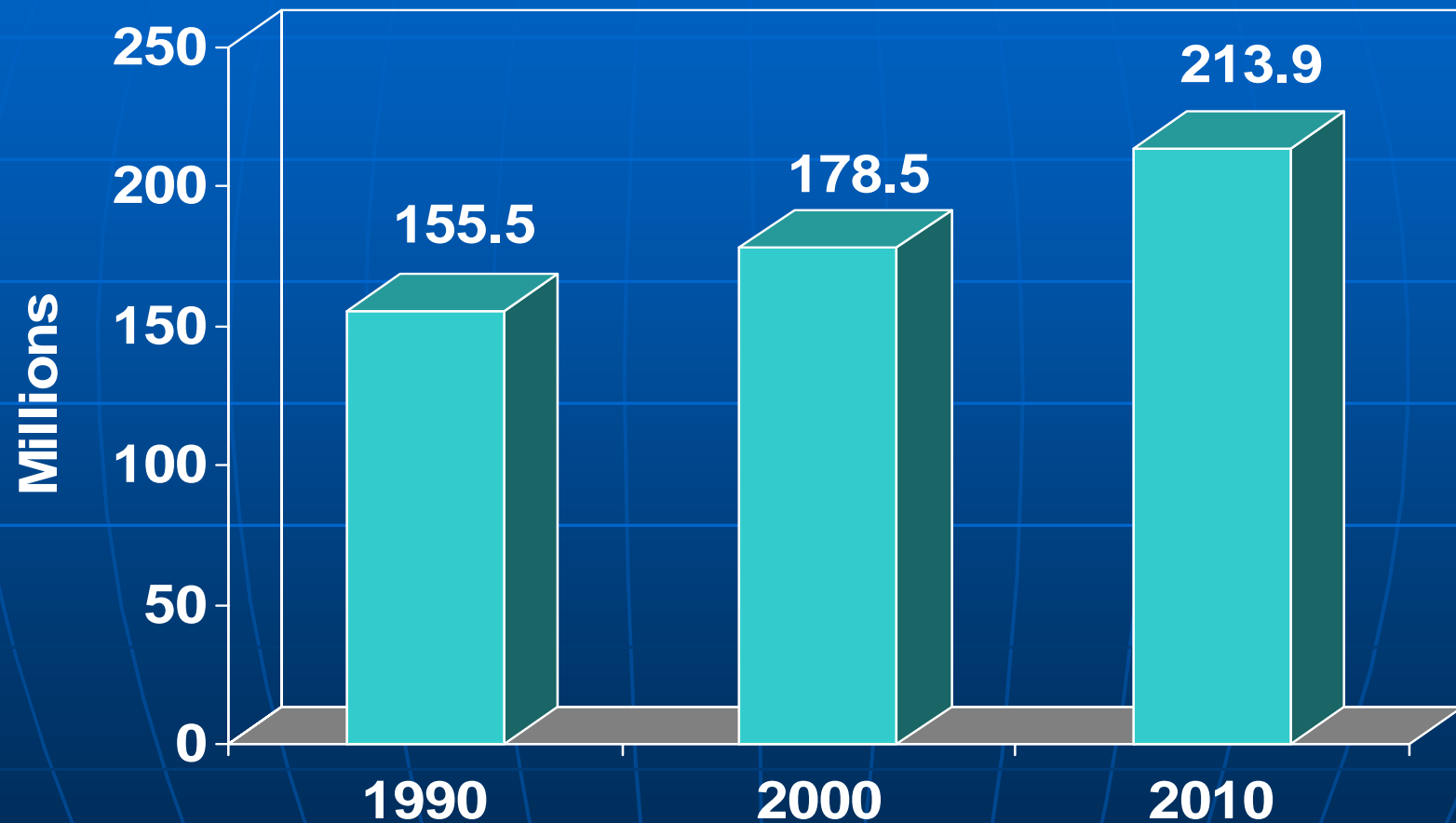
Methodology II (available data)

Estimates produced for all countries with a total population of 100,000 or more (196 countries)

Percentage of countries with available data	68.4	74.5	50.5
Percentage of migrants covered with available data	60.3	84.9	76.2

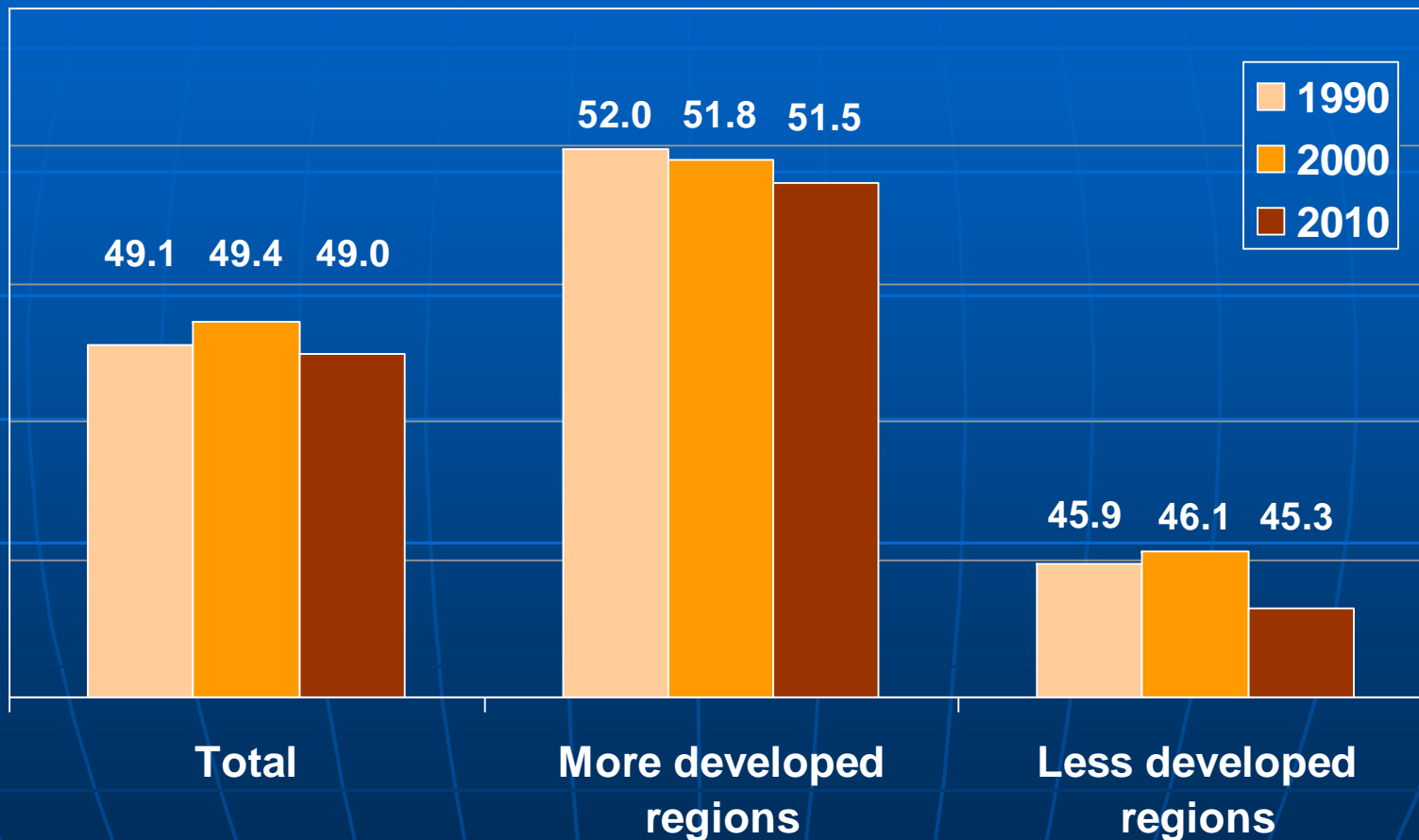

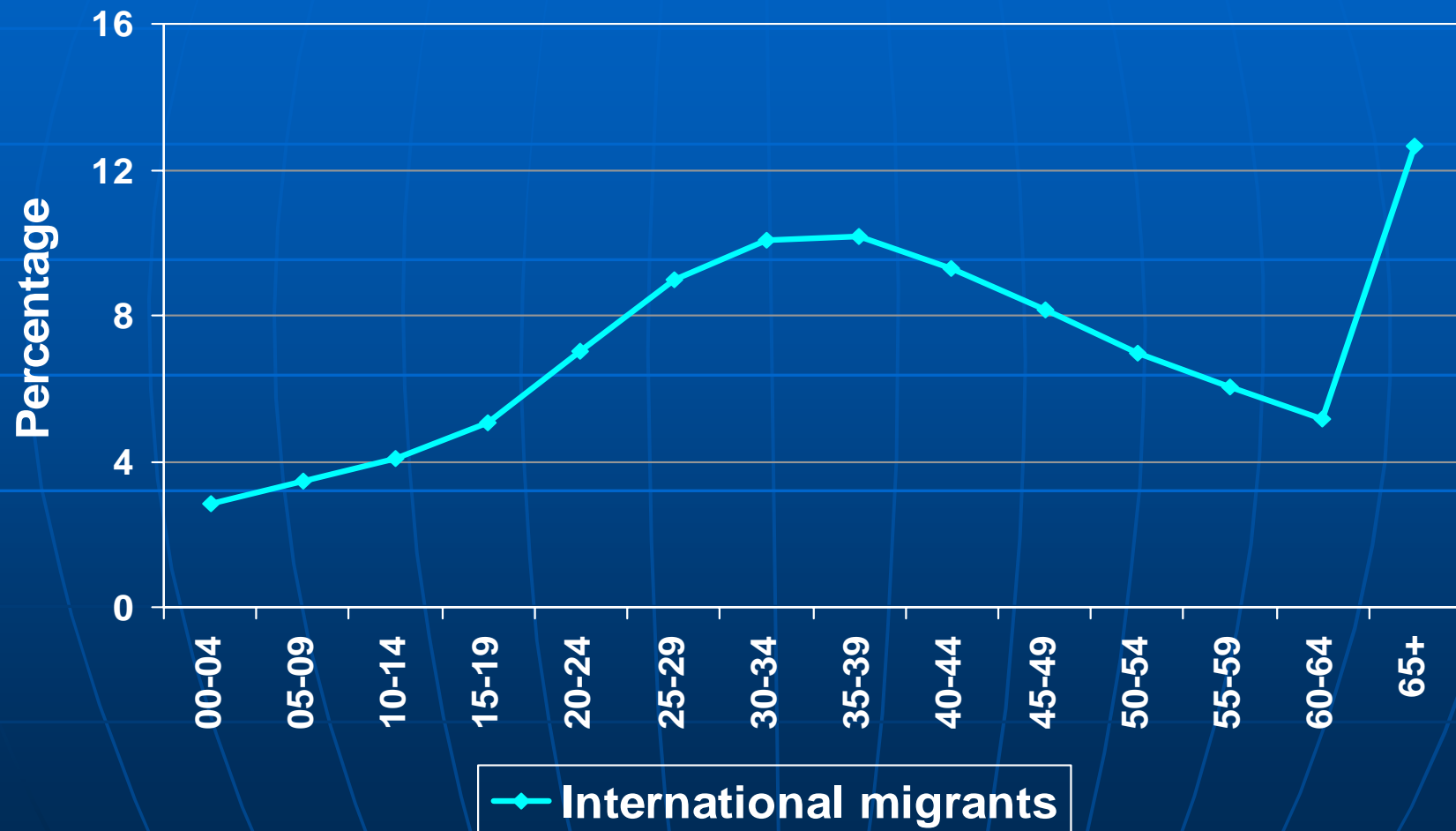
Female percentage of the international migrant stock

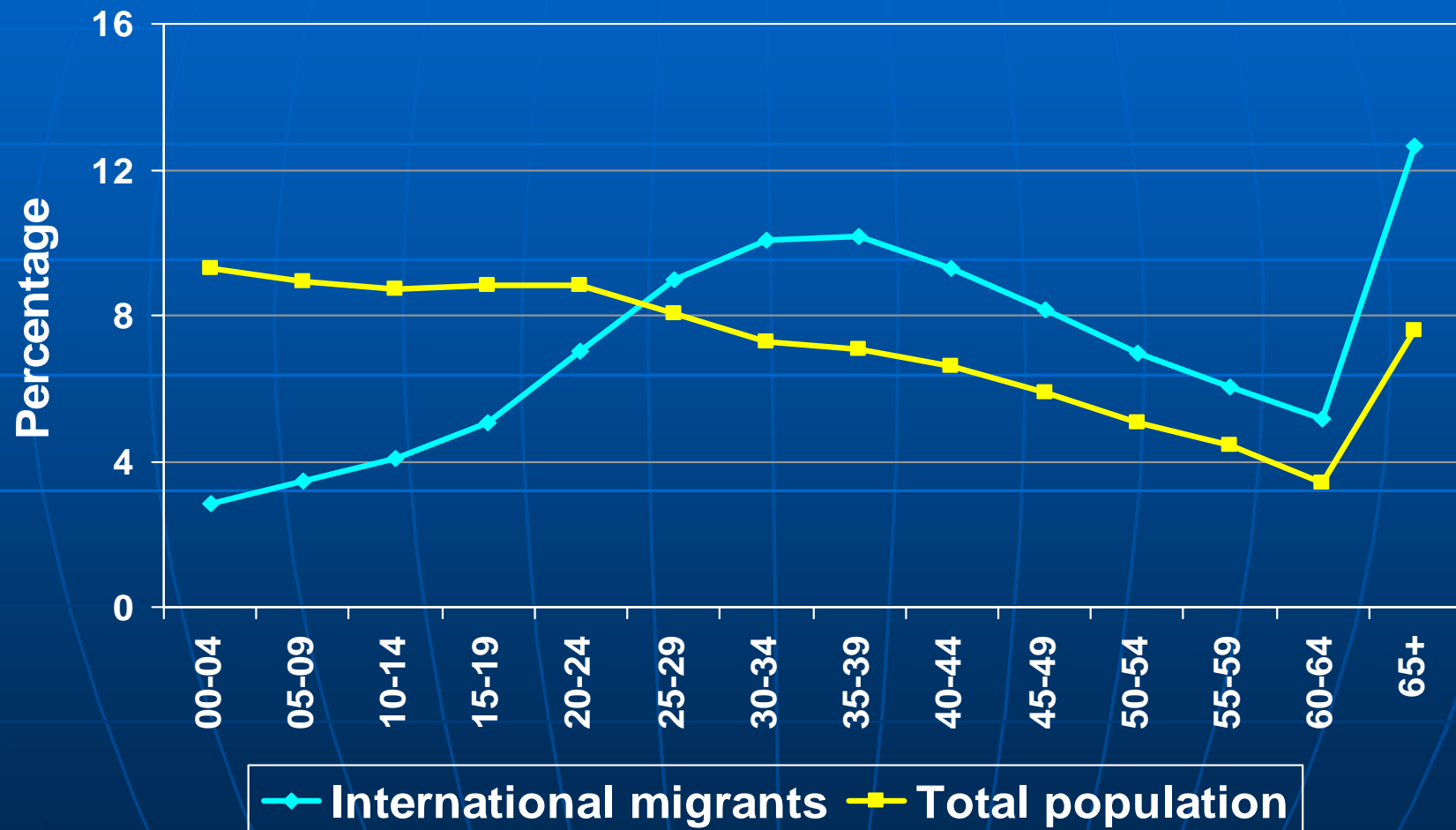

Age distribution of the international migrant stock and total population - 2010



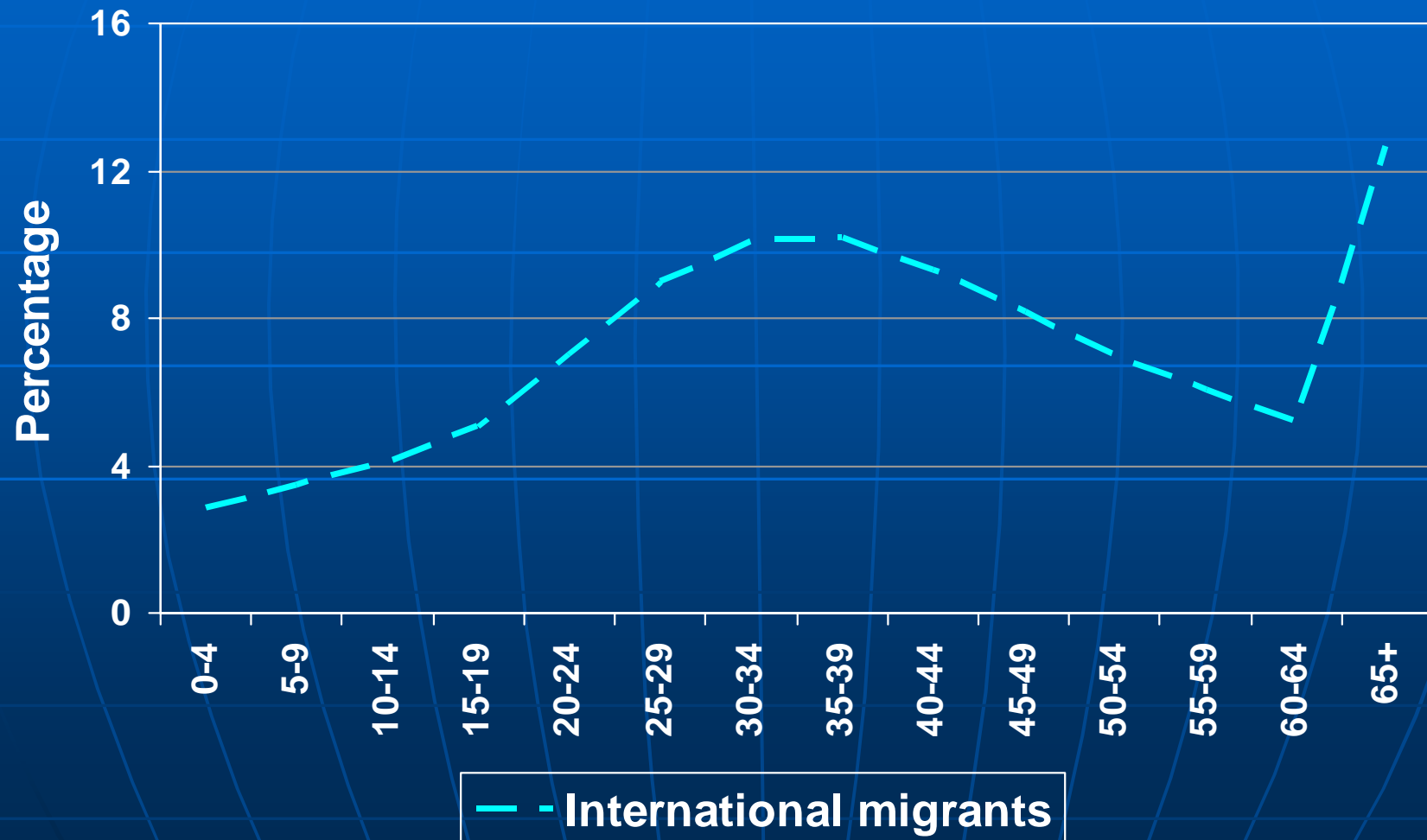

Age distribution of the international migrant stock and total population - 2010



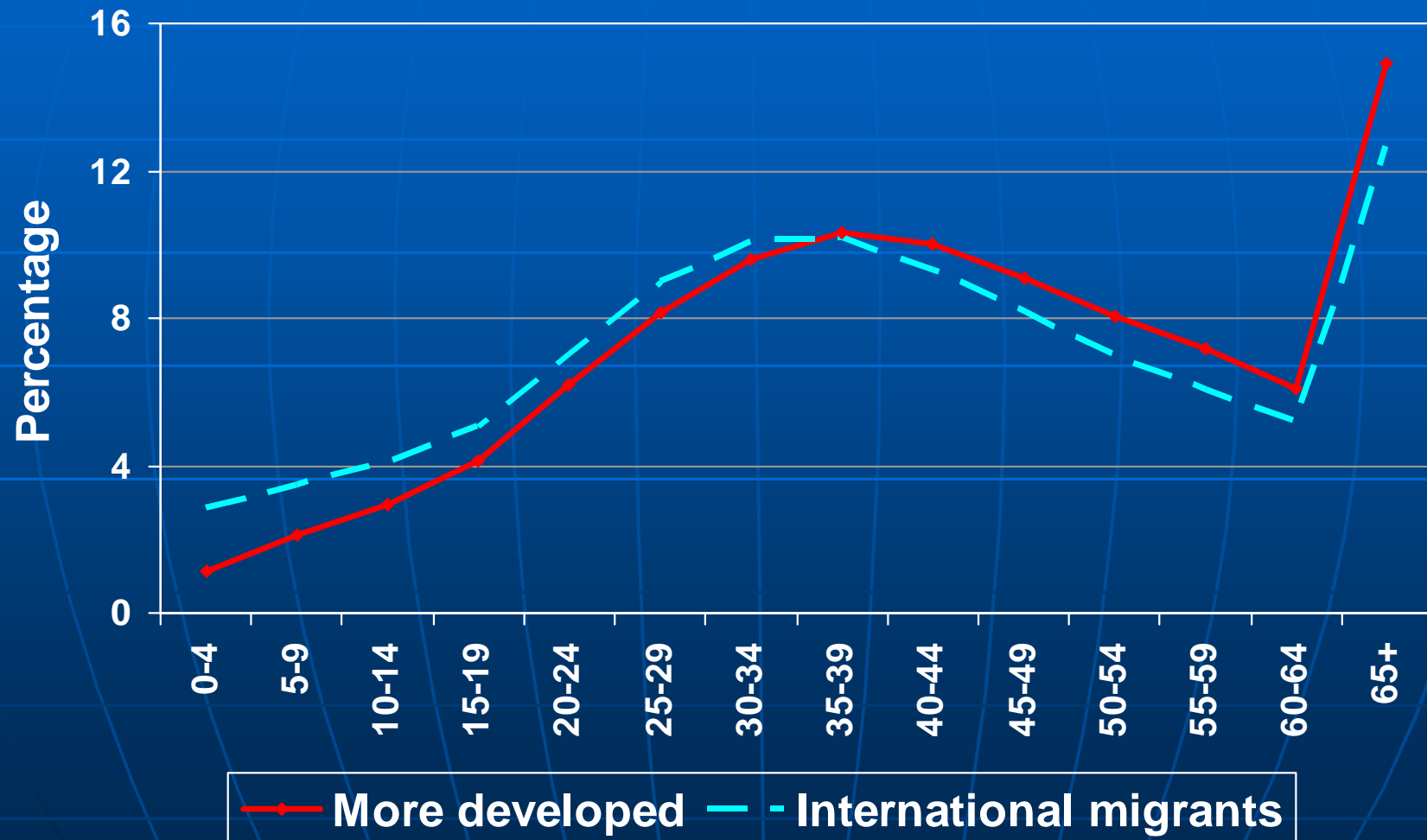

Age distribution of the international migrant stock by development level - 2010



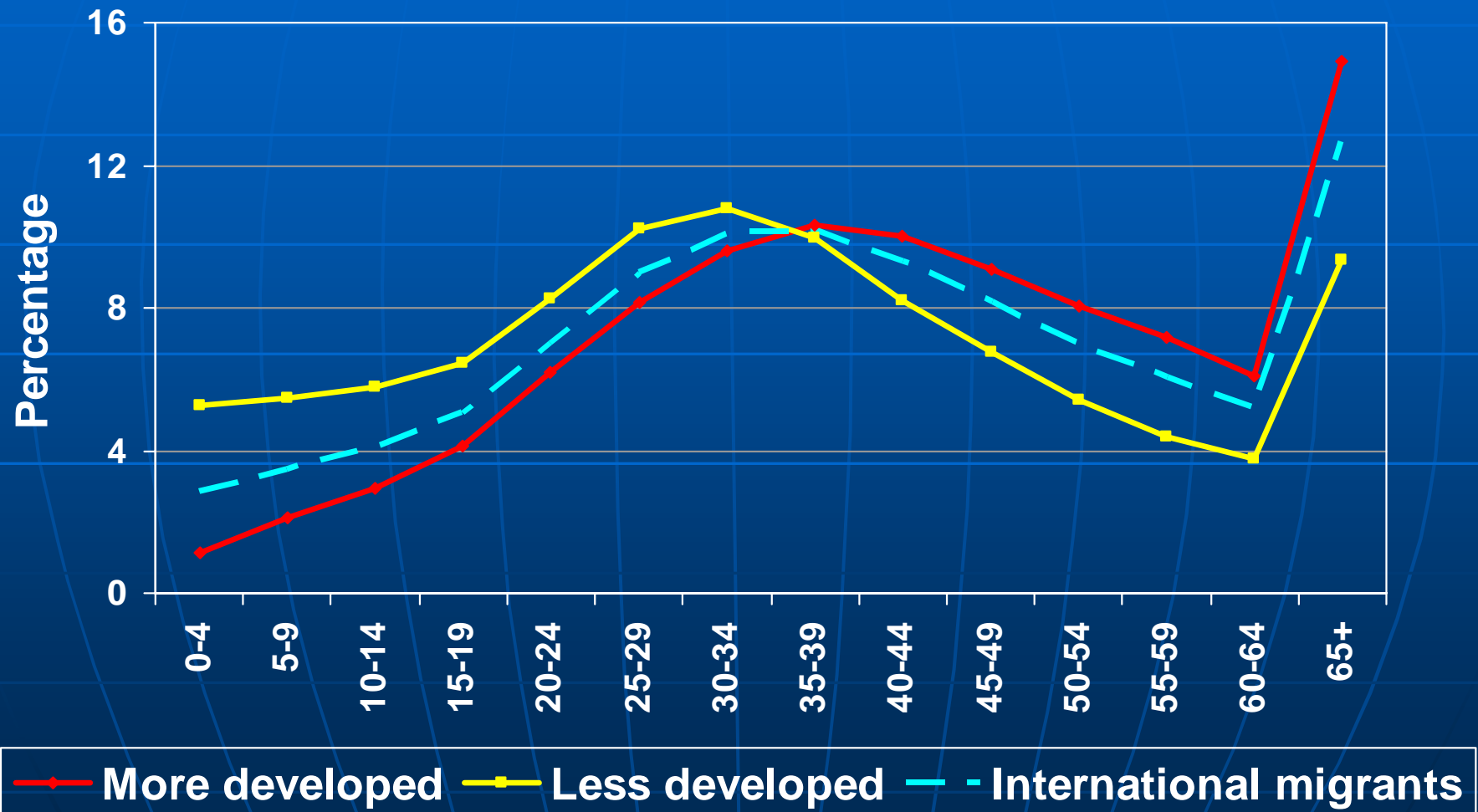

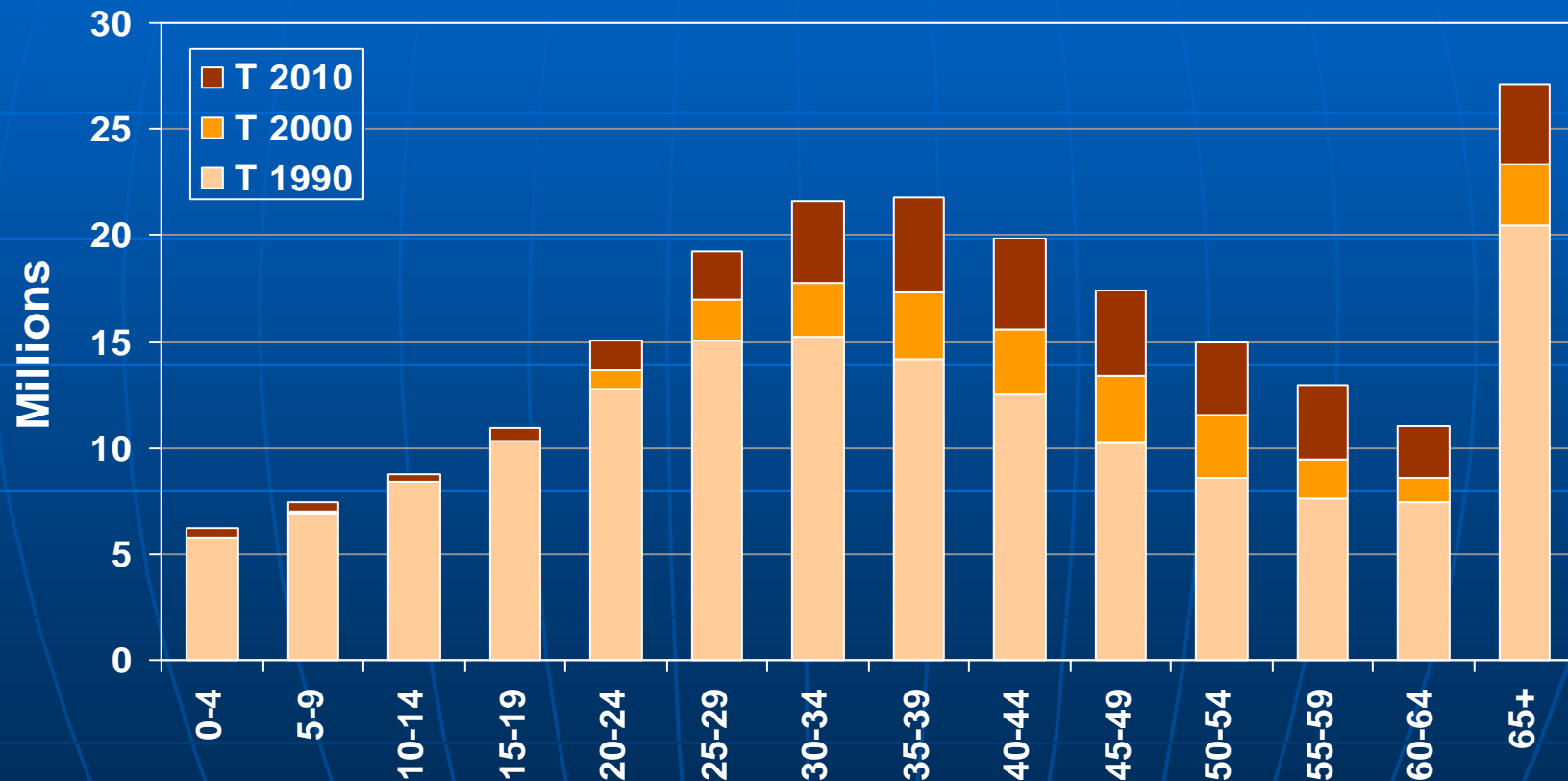
Age distribution of the international migrant stock by development level - 2010

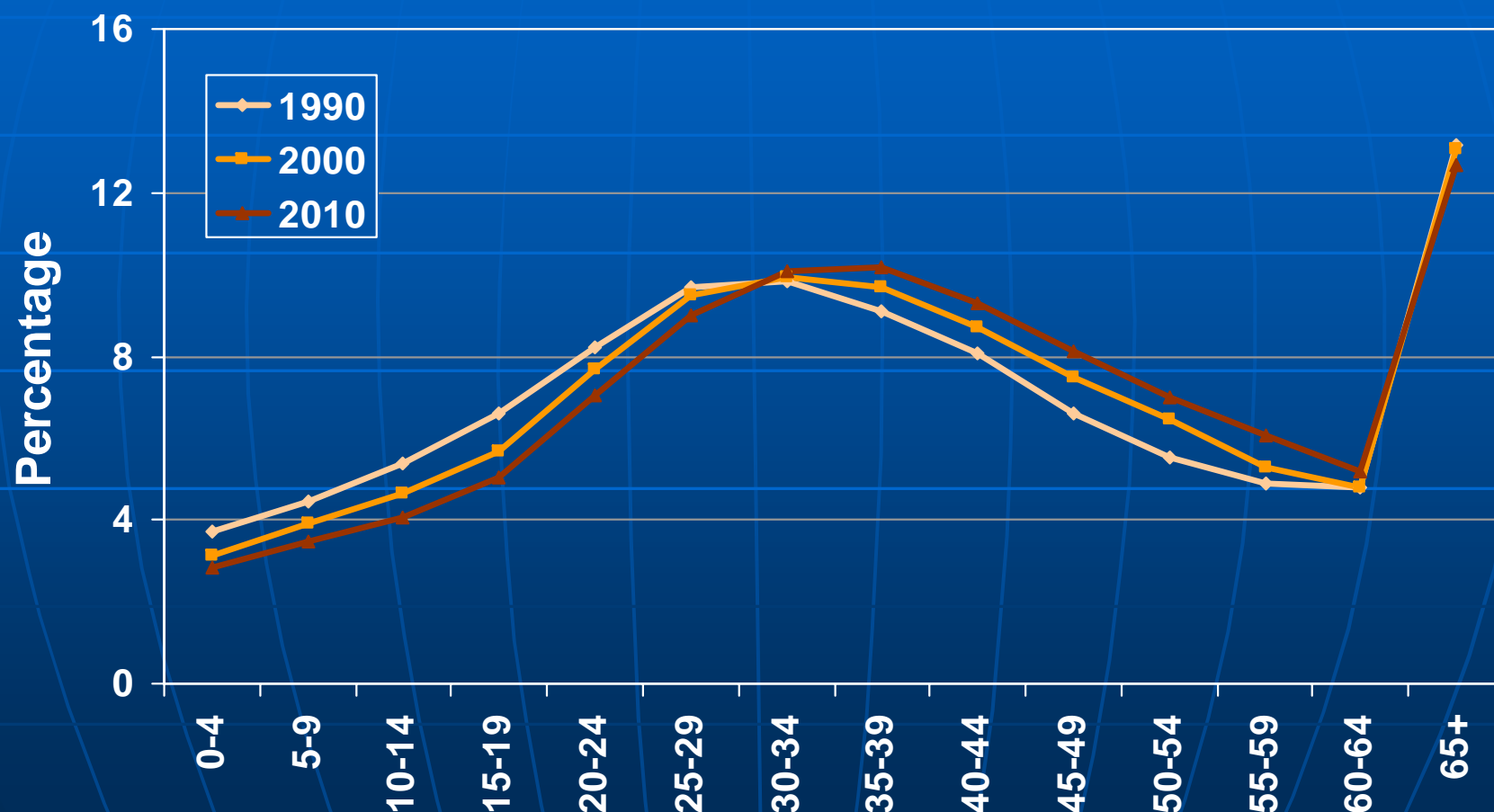

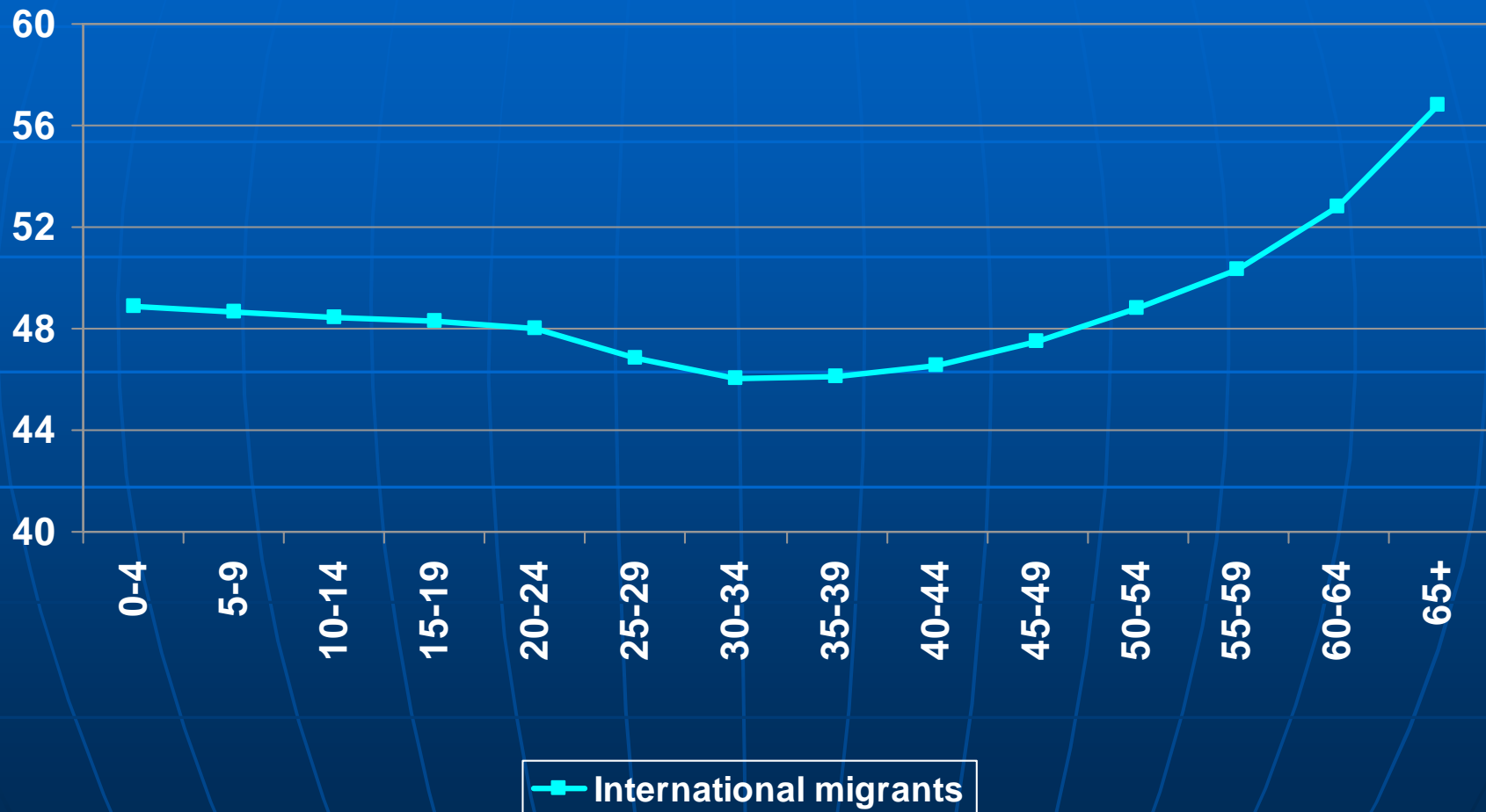
Age distribution of the international migrant stock 1990, 2000 and 2010

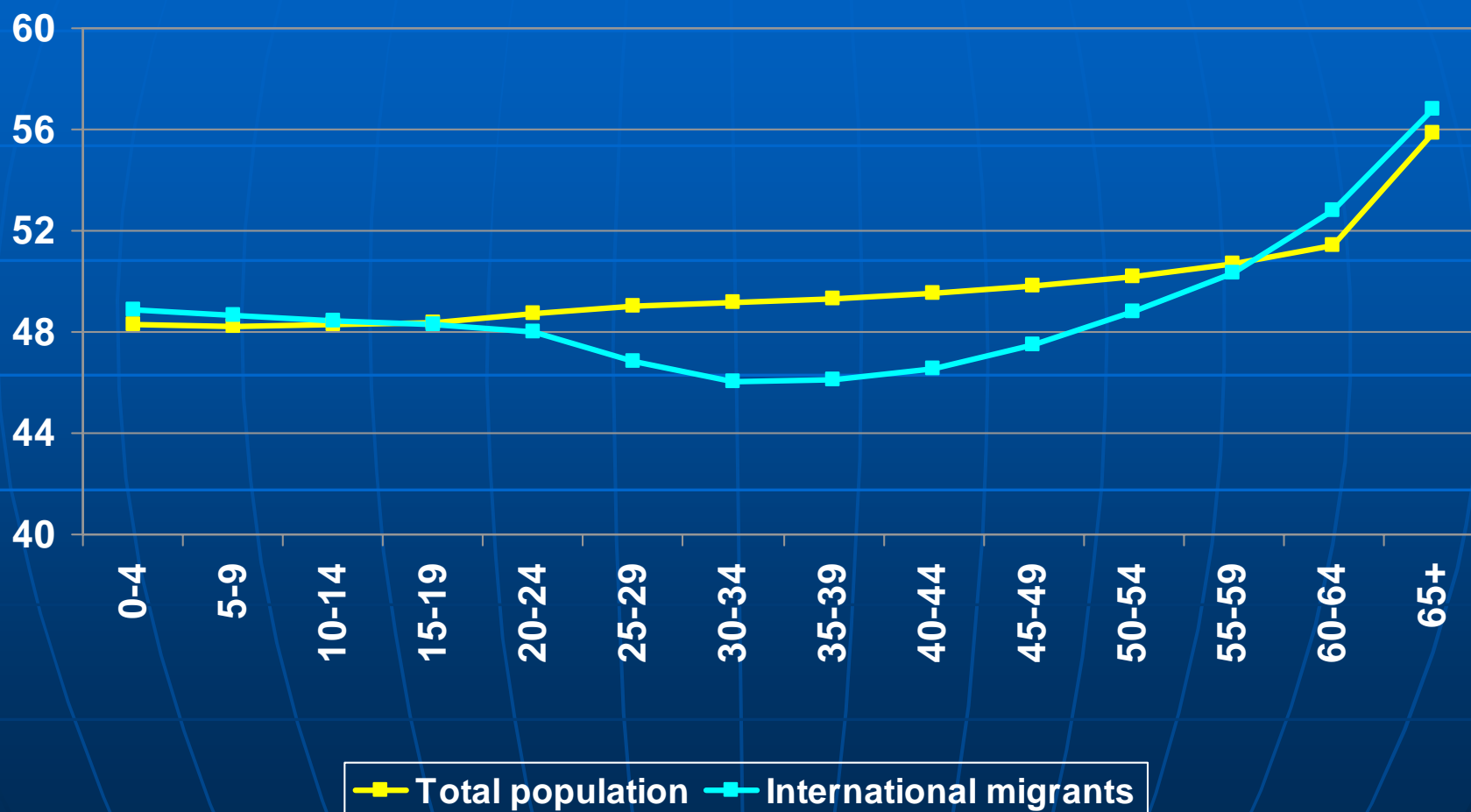

Percentage female by five-year age group, 2010



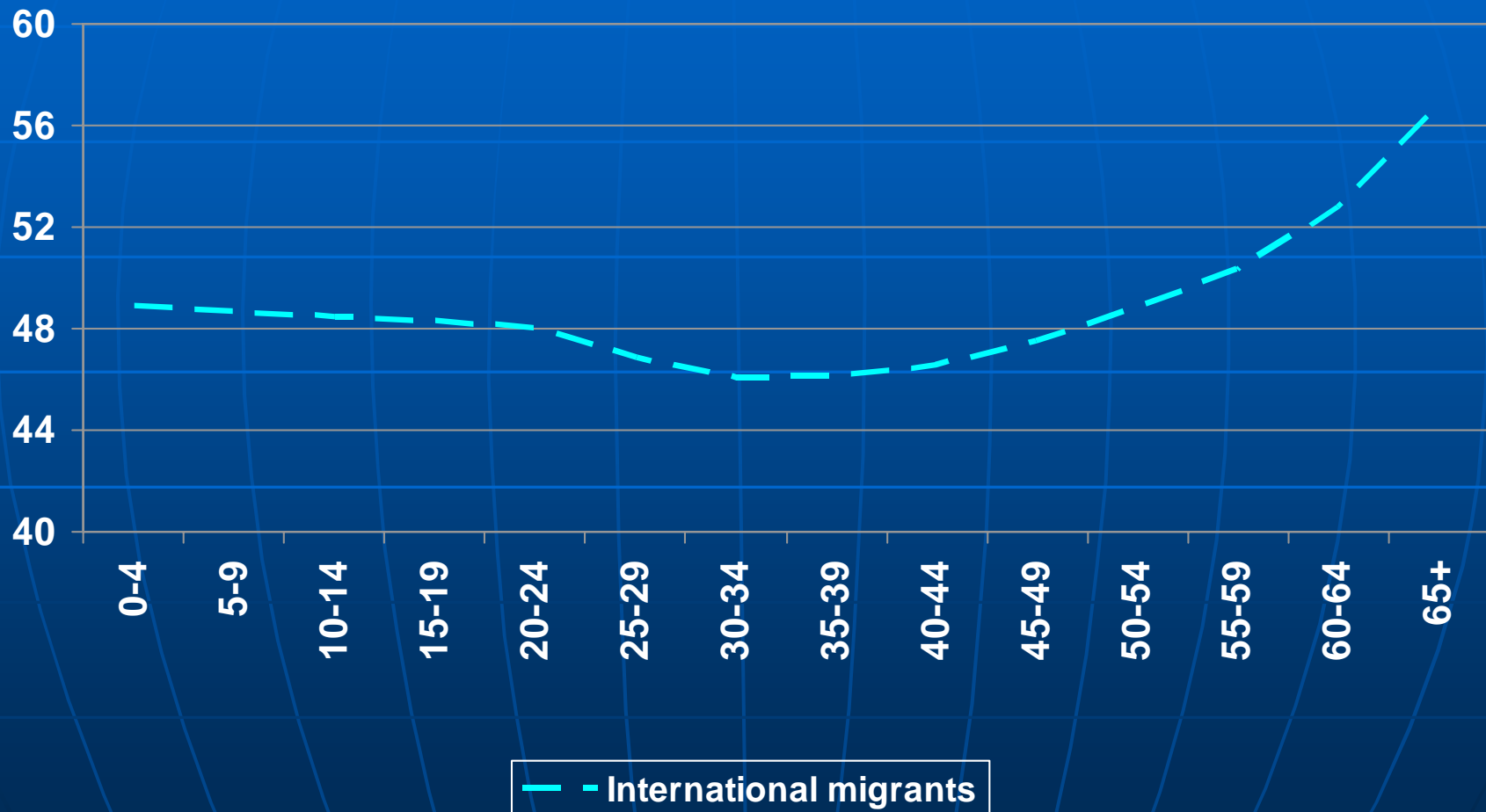

Percentage female by five-year age group, 2010



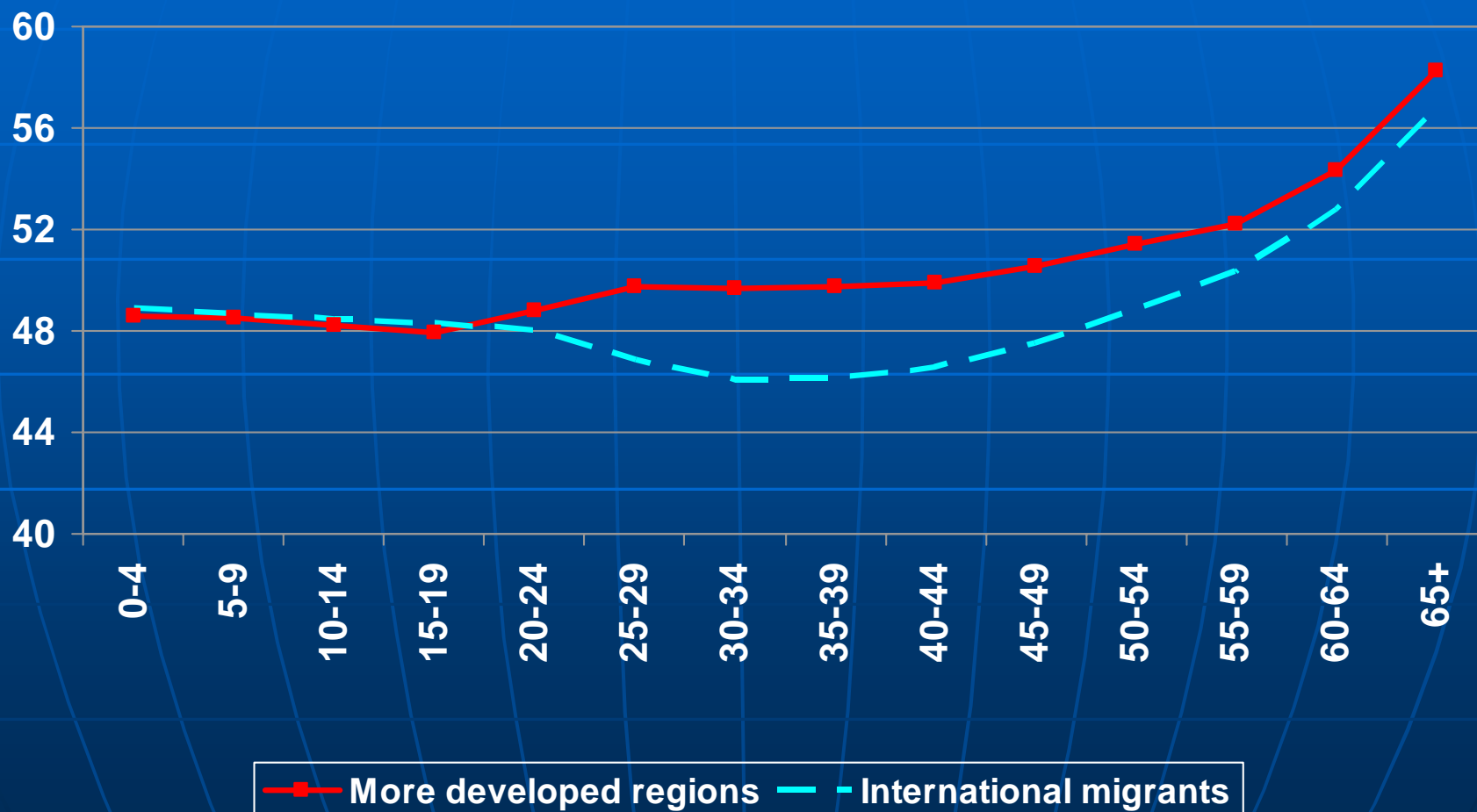

Percentage female by five-year age group, 2010



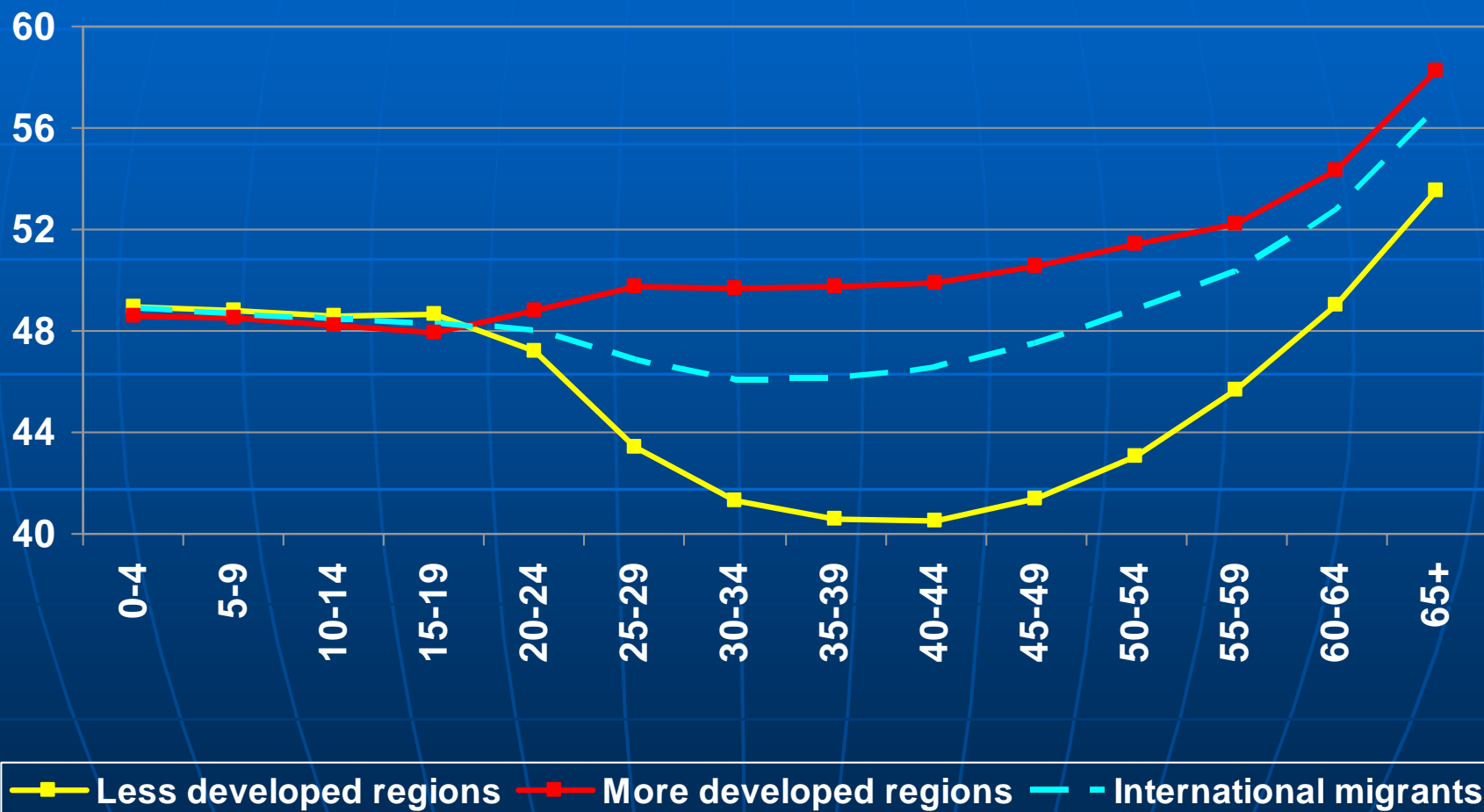

Percentage female by five-year age group, 2010



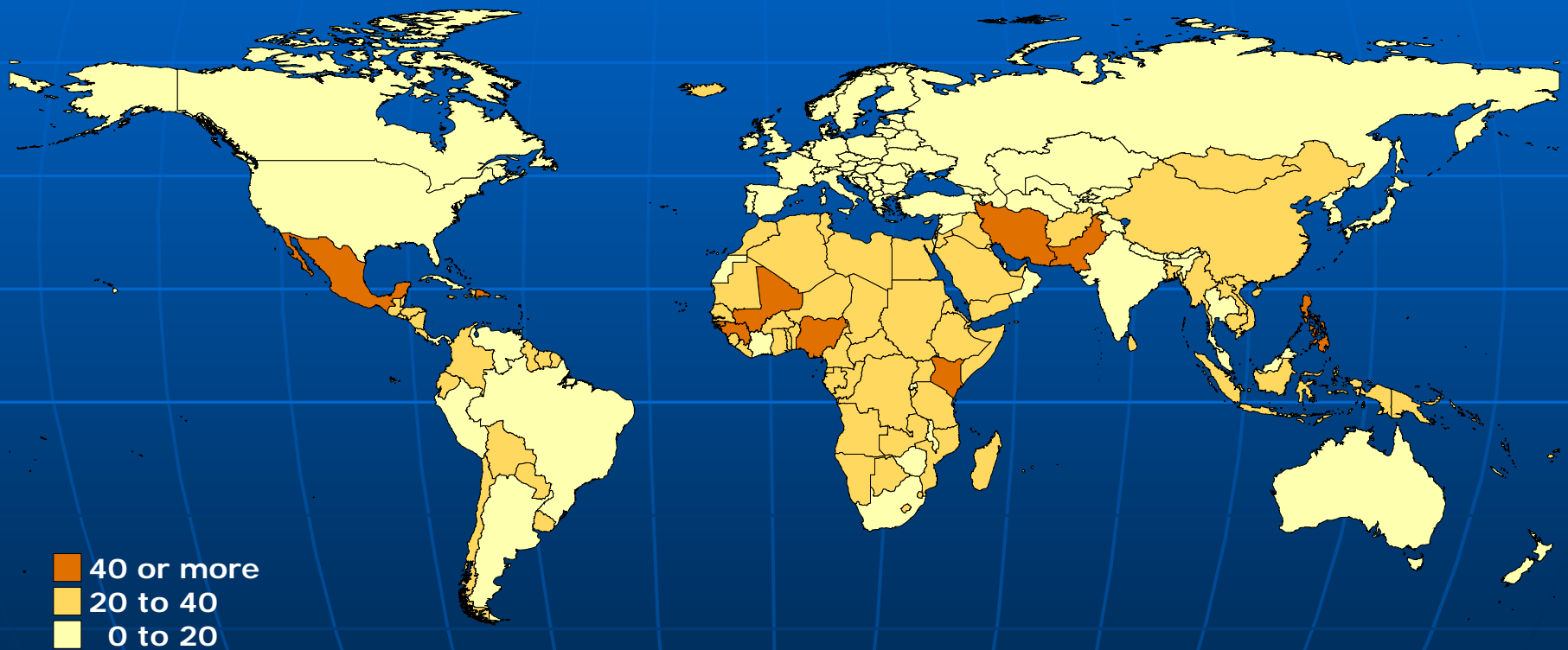
