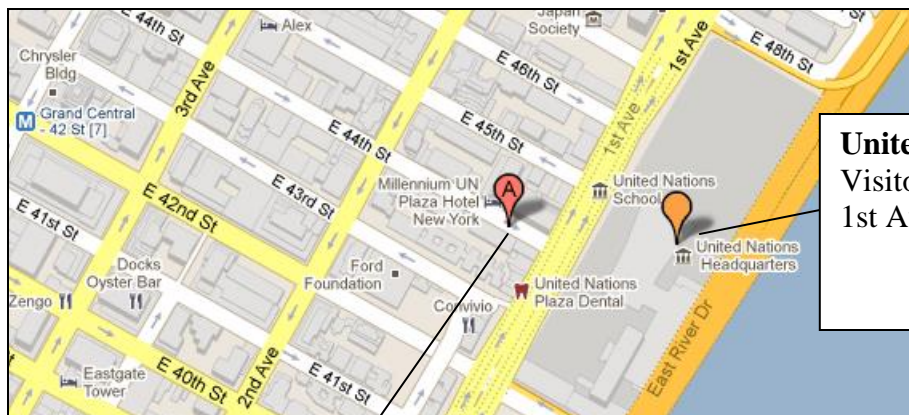
**Time and venue of the meeting**

The meeting will take place at United Nations Headquarters in New York. The meeting will be held in conference room 11 of the Conference Room Building, located in the United Nations Headquarters. **Temporary passes for non-United Nations participants**

Persons without a valid United Nations grounds pass or a United Nations Laissez Passer are required to come to the lobby of the DC-2 Building, located at Two United Nations Plaza, 44th Street between 1st and 2nd Avenues on 16 February 2017 (Thursday) from 9:00 am to 9:30 am in order to pick up a temporary UN grounds pass. Persons with a valid United Nations grounds pass or a United Nations Laissez Passer are required to bring these with them in order to obtain access to the meeting venue.
