
Time and venue of the meeting

The meeting will be held in the Trusteeship Council Chamber of the Conference Building at United Nations Headquarters in New York. Temporary passes for non-United Nations participants

Persons without a valid United Nations grounds pass or a United Nations Laissez Passer and who have registered online are required to come to the lobby of the DC-2 Building, located at Two United Nations Plaza, 44th Street between 1st and 2nd Avenues on 26 February 2019 (Tuesday) from 9:00 to 9:30 in order to pick up a temporary UN grounds pass. Persons with a valid United Nations grounds pass or a United Nations Laissez Passer are required to bring these with them in order to obtain access to the meeting venue. Persons who are unable to pick up their temporary passes on Tuesday from 9:00 to 9:30, should contact the Migration Team, Population Division (migrationp@un.org) or the Office of the Director (tel: 212-963-3209).

These contributions will be posted on the website of the meeting without formal editing.
