

### **Registration of Official Delegations**

All registration requests must be made via the online system "eRegistration" that is available through the e-deleGATE Portal at <a href="https://edelegate.un.int">https://edelegate.un.int</a>.




- There is no need to register diplomats/staff of the missions/offices in New York, who are already in possession of a UN grounds pass.
- One registration for all high-level meetings/events including the general debate between **18-26 September 2023**.
- The deadline for submission of registration is **Friday**, 8 **September 2023**.



### Registration of Official Delegations (cont'd)

- It is not necessary to register delegates as virtual participants in order to follow the general debate and other high-level meetings online, which are available at **webtv.un.org**.
- Missions/Offices are strongly encouraged to submit **photographs** of delegations along with their online registration requests in order to avoid long queues at the Pass and I.D. office.



### Registration of Official Delegations (cont'd)

- All registration requests require <u>at least 2 to 3 business days</u> for processing. Again, the deadline for online registration is <u>Friday</u>, <u>8 September 2023</u>.
- ❖ VVIP and VIP Passes are issued by UN Protocol and may be collected at the same time as the distribution of the access cards on 14 September 2023, and thereafter, in the Protocol Office in Room S-0200 during office hours.
- **VVIP Passes** (without photo) will be issued to Heads of State/Government, Vice-Presidents and Crown Princes/Princesses, and their spouses.
- **VIP Passes** (with photo) will be issued to Deputy Prime Ministers, Cabinet Ministers and Speakers of Parliaments, and their spouses.

# Secondary access passes & floaters

- For access to restricted areas, everyone needs a secondary access card OR a meeting-specific ticket in addition to a valid UN grounds pass.
- There will be different types of color-coded access cards and special tickets as follows:

### Types of secondary access cards

- Gold
  - Access to all areas (Including GA hall)
  - Blue floater
- Access to the third, second, ground floor and the first basement
- Orange floater
- Access to parts of the third floor and parts of the first basement
- Special ticket
  - Access to conference room (event and date specific)

# Secondary access passes & floaters (cont'd)

**▶ Bearing in mind space constraints,** as well as security considerations, passes will be issued as follows:

### GENERAL DEBATE (19-26 Sept 2023)

Access to the General Assembly Hall and "all restricted areas" on the third floor, second floor, ground floor and first basement of the GA and Conference Buildings for the general debate from 19 to 26 September 2023

#### For each member state:

• 6 gold cards, 4 blue floaters and 2 orange floaters

#### For each GA-accredited IGO:

2 gold cards, 2 blue floaters and 2 orange floaters

### For each specialized agency and related organization:

1 gold card, 2 blue floaters and 2 orange floaters





### **Meeting-specific tickets**

### **SDG SUMMIT (18-19 Sept 2023)**


Access to the <u>General Assembly Hall</u> and <u>other conference rooms</u> for the <u>SDG Summit on 18 and 19 September 2023</u>

#### For each member state:

- 6 tickets for the opening meeting in the GA Hall and all areas of the GA and Conference Buildings for 18 September
- 2 tickets for the <u>Leaders Dialogues</u> in the <u>Trusteeship Council</u> Chamber for 18 September (after 10:30 am)
- **2 tickets** for the <u>Leaders Dialogues and the closing meeting</u> in the **Trusteeship Council Chamber** for **19 September** (afternoon)

#### For each IGO:

- 2 tickets for the <u>opening meeting</u> in the GA Hall and all areas of the GA and Conference Buildings for 18 September
- 1 ticket for the <u>Leaders Dialogues</u> in the <u>Trusteeship Council Chamber</u> for 18 September (after 10:30 am)
- 1 ticket for the <u>Leaders Dialogues and the closing meeting</u> in the Trusteeship Council Chamber for 19 September (afternoon)

# Meeting-specific tickets (cont'd)

#### For each specialized agency and related organization:

- 1 ticket for the <u>opening meeting</u> in the GA Hall and all areas of the GA and Conference Buildings for 18 September
- 1 ticket for the <u>Leaders Dialogues</u> in the <u>Trusteeship Council Chamber</u> for 18 <u>September (after 10:30 am)</u>
- 1 ticket for the <u>Leaders Dialogues and the closing meeting</u> in the <u>Trusteeship Council Chamber</u> for 19 September (afternoon)
- For <u>most high-level meetings</u> taking place from 18 to 26 September 2023, <u>meeting-specific tickets</u> for access to various conference rooms will be issued to representatives of Member and Observer States, GA-accredited IGOs, specialized agencies and related organizations participating in these meetings. These tickets will allow access to the conference room on the date and time stated on the ticket for the specific meetings. The meeting room can be accessed via the restricted areas of the General Assembly and Conference Buildings on the date and time of the respective meeting. Additional details will be made available in due course.
- Secondary access cards and meeting-specific tickets will be <u>distributed</u> by the Protocol Office on Thursday, 14 September 2023 between 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm in Conference Room "A" in the 1<sup>st</sup> basement. Thereafter, access cards may be collected in the Protocol Office in Room S-0200 during office hours.



### Reservation for guests of delegations


- During the address of the heads of delegations at the plenary meeting of the general debate, seats will be reserved in a <u>VIP Section B</u> for spouses of the Heads of State or Government, Vice-Presidents and Crown Princes or Princesses.
- In addition, a maximum of <u>8 seats</u> (on a rotation basis) may be reserved for guests of delegations in <u>VIP Section A</u>.





### Reservation for guests of delegations (cont'd)


A limited number of seats in the Balcony on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor of the GA Hall will also be available for reservation for guests of delegations. Special courtesy tickets for these areas are required. Missions may submit their reservations by using an <u>online SG.40 form</u> (Reservation for courtesy tickets) under the "Protocol" dropdown menu (4th tab – Reservation for courtesy tickets for the general debate) in the eDelegate portal (<a href="https://edelegate.un.int/portal/protocol/tickets">https://edelegate.un.int/portal/protocol/tickets</a>). Reservation will open on 5 September 2023.





### Welcome by the Secretary-General








### **Escort from GA-200 to Rostrum**

During the general debate, there will be <u>no</u> ceremonial chair on the stage and no handshakes after the address.








### **State Luncheon**
