ALLOCATION OF AGENDA ITEMS

Letter dated 13 November 1951 from the President of the
General Assembly to the Chairman of the
First Committee

At its 342nd plenary meeting, the General Assembly decided to allocate to the First Committee the following items on the agenda of the sixth regular session:

1. International control of atomic energy: report of the Committee of Twelve; ||
2. The problem of the independence of Korea: report of the United Nations Commission for the Unification and Rehabilitation of Korea;
3. Methods which might be used to maintain and strengthen international peace and security in accordance with the Purposes and Principles of the Charter: report of the Collective Measures Committee;
4. Threats to the political independence and territorial integrity of China and to the peace of the Far East, resulting from Soviet violations of the Sino-Soviet Treaty of Friendship and Alliance of 14 August 1945 and from Soviet violations of the Charter of the United Nations;
5. Admission of new Members, including the right of candidate States to present proof of the conditions required under Article 4 of the Charter;
6. Regulation, limitation and balanced reduction of all armed forces and all armaments; ||
7. Measures to combat the threat of a new world war and to strengthen peace and friendship among the nations.
