1. Role of the Special Committee in the future for decolonization in the Non-Self-Governing Territories on a case-by-case basis:
 - (a) Review and assessment of the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples and the Third International Decade for the Eradication of Colonialism, with a view towards strengthening the work of the Committee;
 - (b) What are the prospects for decolonization in the Non-Self-Governing Territories in the light of the remaining years of the Third International Decade for the Eradication of Colonialism?.
2. Perspectives of the administering Powers, territorial Governments, concerned Member States and other stakeholders, as well as views of experts on the decolonization process:
 - (a) Political developments in the Non-Self-Governing Territories:
 - (i) In the Caribbean region;
 - (ii) In the Pacific region;
 - (iii) In other regions;
 - (b) Strengthening cooperation with the administering Powers, the Non-Self-Governing Territories, concerned Member States and other stakeholders on a case-by-case basis, in accordance with the relevant United Nations resolutions, according to the Third International Decade for the Eradication of Colonialism and Agenda 2030 for Sustainable Development, especially its economic dimension, taking into account the indivisible nature of the Sustainable Development Goals:
 - (i) In the Caribbean region;
 - (ii) In the Pacific region;
 - (iii) In other regions.

3. Role of the United Nations system in providing development assistance to Non-Self-Governing Territories taking into account the Third International Decade for the Eradication of Colonialism and Agenda 2030 for Sustainable Development, and in accordance with relevant United Nations resolutions: presentations by the funds and programmes, specialized agencies, regional economic commissions and others.
