## Plenary Sessions

- Opening Statements: President of the Conference, UNSG, PGA, a representative from the migrant community and a representative from the private sector.
- Heads of State or Government, ministers and heads of delegation attending the Conference will be able to make formal statements
- Time permitting, statements from representatives of IGOs, multi-stakeholders.
- Secondary passes will be required to access to the Plenary Hall for the opening ceremony on 10 December.



## Dialogues (Action on commitments, Partnerships and innovative initiatives)

- Two separate interactive Dialogues on 10 and 11 December respectively
- Open for Member States and multi-stakeholders
- Include a keynote speaker and three panelists each
- Structured around the 23 GCM objectives, 4 levels of implementation and different implementing actors
- Focus on inspiring examples of actions, measures, policies and approaches to GCM implementation by Member States and other stakeholders on ways and means of implementing the GCM
