6. The Compact has also outlined the responsibilities of each country in addressing all stages of migration.

Excellencies,

7. The adoption of the Global Compact is only the beginning... its implementation is the key.
8. In this connection, Indonesia would like to underline three important points:
9. **First, the protection of the rights of all migrants** regardless of their status is vital.
10. The GCM, therefore, should serve as guiding principles... in the promotion and protection of the rights of migrants, notably migrant workers.
11. The mechanism to provide consular protection and assistance to all migrants must be established.

→ **empowering them to contribute positively to economic development.**

→ **reducing the push factors** of irregular migration.

21. These are the types of efforts that we must explore together.

22. **Third, national, regional and global actions must work in synergy.**

23. Concerted efforts at the national, regional and global level is necessary to ensure the effective implementation of the GCM.

→ Especially in **creating an enabling environment** to achieve safe, orderly, and regular migration at work.

24. At the national level, all GCM policies and actions must be incorporated into national programs.

25. For its part, Indonesia has recently passed Law No. 18 of 2017 on the Protection of Indonesian Migrant Workers...

31. The adoption of the GCM is a testament of our collective commitment to achieve safe, orderly, and regular migration.

32. Moreover, it is a reflection of our commitment to uphold the values of humanity.

33. We are ready to work together. I hope you are too.
