Population: 48 (2017) ; this figure includes individuals temporarily abroad

Land area: 35.5 km² (Pitcairn Island: 4.35 km²)

Exclusive economic zone: 800,000 km²

Listing as a Non-Self-Governing Territory

Pitcairn has been on the United Nations list of Non-Self-Governing Territories since 1946, following the declaration of the intention by the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to transmit information on the **High Commission Territories of the Western Pacific** (which had included the Pitcairn Islands) under Article 73 *e* of the Charter of the United Nations.
