► Low-income countries confronting severe structural impediments to sustainable development

#### LDC review

- List of LDCs reviewed triennially by the Committee for Development Policy (CDP)
- Currently 48 countries are included in the list of LDCs




#### LDC identification criteria

- Per capita gross national income (GNI)
- Human assets index (HAI)
- Economic vulnerability index (EVI)

# **Graduation from the LDC category**

#### **Graduation eligibility**

- Graduation threshold must be met for two of the three criteria (per capita GNI, HAI, EVI)
- Alternatively, per capita GNI is at least twice the graduation threshold

#### **Graduation procedure**

- Eligibility for graduation has to be met at two consecutive triennial reviews
- After country has been found eligible for graduation for the first time, UN/DESA prepares an ex ante impact assessment, and UNCTAD prepares a vulnerability profile of that country as inputs to the CDP decision-making process
- Country is invited to present its views on the possibility of graduation at the CDP expert group meeting preceding the next triennial review
- CDP recommends the country for graduation on the basis of the LDC criteria and the additional information provided by the country, UN/DESA and UNCTAD
- ▶ ECOSOC endorses the recommendation by the CDP
- General Assembly takes note of the decision of ECOSOC
- Graduation takes effect three years after the decision by the General Assembly

## Graduation thresholds (2015 triennial review)

► Per capita GNI: \$1,242

\$2,484 for income only

HAI: 66 and aboveEVI: 32 and below



# Per capita gross national income (GNI)




