

# Why should the focus on LDCs, LLDCs and SIDS be part of the global development agenda?







## Possible ways to reflect the special situation of the most vulnerable countries in the new global partnership

Need to build resilience for long-term sustainable and equitable development

The goal of capacity building, which includes statistical and technological capacity as well as the capacity to deal with risks, should be more explicit in a new framework

Flexibility and policy space needs to be increased to ensure true ownership

LDC, LLDC and SIDS vulnerabilities and needs should be a priority in the post 2015 development agenda to address inequality between countries





#### The IPoA and the post 2015 development agenda

**The IPoA** constitutes a renewed partnership for LDCs, including South-South cooperation and non-government stakeholders

#### First priority of the IPoA: productive capacities

- transfer of technology
- incentives for investment
- •measures to promote trade especially in labour intensive industries
- leveraging of ODA to increase other capital inflows

#### Priority on multiple crises and other emerging challenges

- support risk mitigation strategies
- enhance financing for climate change adaptation and mitigation
- •enhance capacities in clean energy production, trade and distribution
- strengthen capacity to reduce vulnerability to natural disasters





### Parallel inter-governmental process related to LDCs, LLDCs and SIDS

- Mid-term review of the Istanbul Programme of Action should be closely linked to the discussion about post-2015 MDG development agenda
- The GA decided to convene in 2014 a 10 year review conference of the Almaty Programme of Action for the LLDCs
- A third global conference on the sustainable development of SIDS is envisaged in 2014

There is a need to coordinate the preparations of such conferences and their outcomes in order to produce maximum synergies with the post-2015 MDG development agenda process
