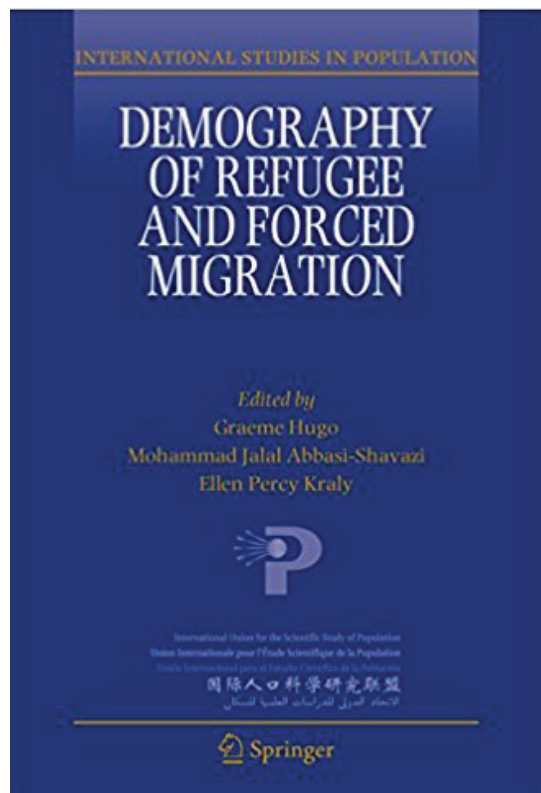

**Ellen Percy Kraly**, is the William R. Kenan, Jr. Professor of Geography at Colgate University. Her work focuses on refugee policy, forced migration and the ethical and human rights aspects of population data. Dr Kraly has contributed to many reports on international migration and was editor-in-chief of the International Migration Review 2011-14. In 2016, she was awarded an honorary doctorate from Curtin University in recognition of her role in the return of Aboriginal children's artwork to Western Australia.
