## Purpose of the Protocols

### TIP Protocol (Article 2)

- **Prevent** and combat trafficking in persons
- **Protect** and assist victims of trafficking
- **Promote** cooperation

### SOM Protocol (Article 2)

- **Prevent** and combat migrant smuggling
- **Protect** the rights of smuggling migrants
- **Promote** cooperation

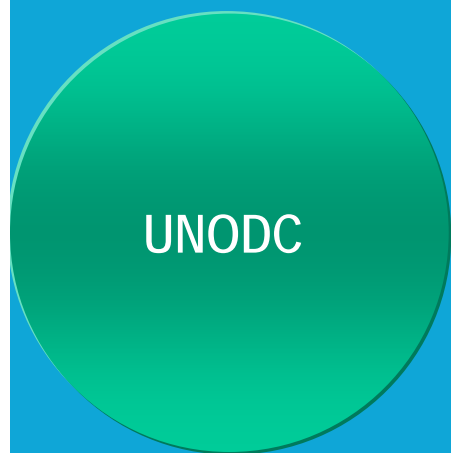
+ 4<sup>th</sup> P = **Prosecute** offenders

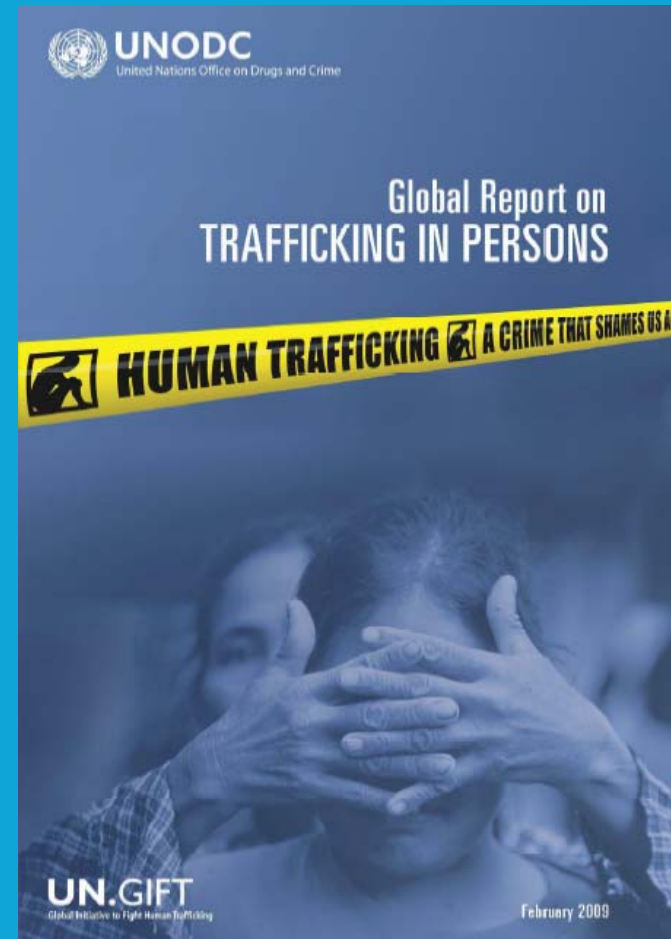
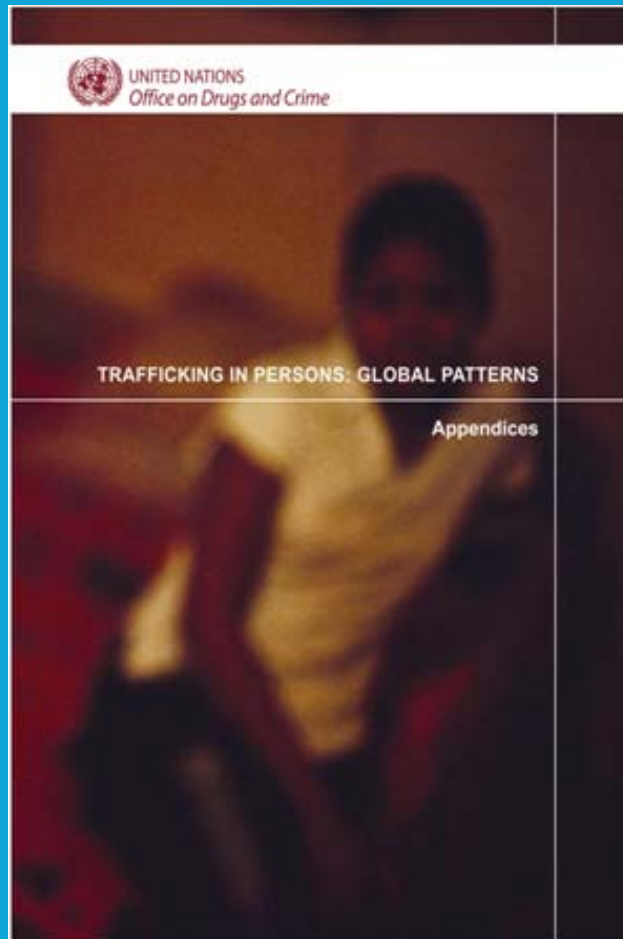

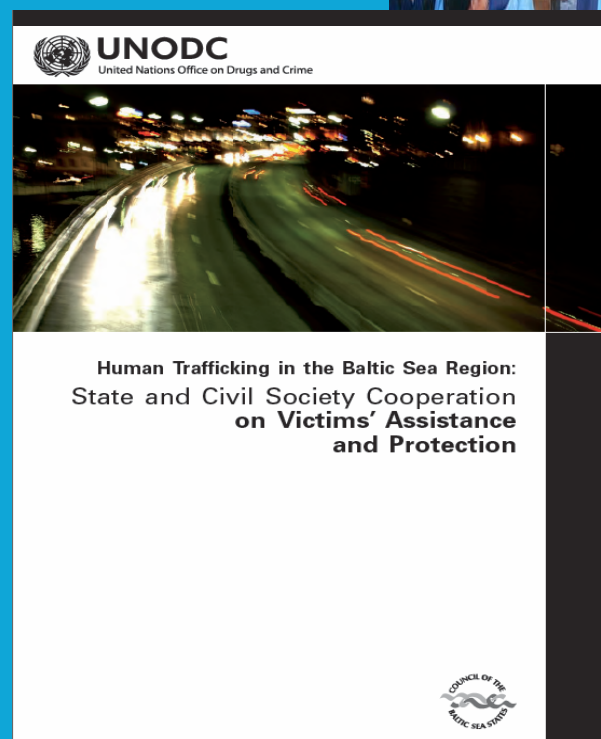
