DRAFT OF OUTCOME DOCUMENT FOR 19 SEPTEMBER 2016 HIGH-LEVEL MEETING TO ADDRESS LARGE MOVEMENTS OF REFUGEES AND MIGRANTS

Cuba would like to add:

- 3.3 bis We will end selective and discriminatory migration policies which stimulate disorganized migration, cause irregular flows and serious difficulties for transit countries. We commit to review and adopt measures to strengthen the fight against trafficking networks that profit from irregular, insecure and disorderly migratory flows, making profit out of migrants, endangering their lives, integrity and dignity and confront this scourge respecting the legal order of each country and international law;
- 3.3 ter We strongly condemns acts, manifestations and expressions of racism, racial discrimination, xenophobia and related intolerance against migrants and the stereotypes often applied to them, including on the basis of religion or belief, and urges States to apply and, where needed, to reinforce existing laws when hate crimes, xenophobic or intolerant acts, manifestations or expressions against migrants occur, in order to eradicate impunity for those who commit those acts and, where appropriate, to provide effective remedy to the victims;
- 3.4 bis We will promote that migrants will be informed about all processes in which they are involved in transit and destination countries, including the options from which they can benefit as a guarantee for the protection of their human rights;
