**Temporary passes for non-United Nations participants**

Persons without a valid United Nations grounds pass or a United Nations Laissez Passer and who have registered online are required to come to the lobby of the DC-2 Building, located at Two United Nations Plaza, 44th Street between 1st and 2nd Avenues on 26 February 2019 (Tuesday) from 9:00 to 9:30 in order to pick up a temporary UN grounds pass. Persons with a valid United Nations grounds pass or a United Nations Laissez Passer are required to bring these with them in order to obtain access to the meeting venue.
