

Resumed substantive session of 2002

2002/201 D. Elections, nominations and appointments to subsidiary and related bodies of the Economic and Social Council

At its 44th plenary meeting, on 25 October 2002, the Economic and Social Council took the following action with regard to vacancies in its subsidiary bodies:

Elections postponed from previous sessions

COMMISSION ON SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY FOR DEVELOPMENT

The Council elected JORDAN for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 2004.

The Council also elected BELGIUM for a four-year term beginning on 1 January 2003.

The Council further postponed to a future session the election of two members from Western European and other States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 2004, and two members from Western European and other States for a four-year term beginning on 1 January 2003.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL WORKING GROUP OF EXPERTS ON INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS OF ACCOUNTING AND REPORTING

The Council elected PANAMA for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2003.

The Council further postponed to a future session the election of one member from Eastern European States and one member from Latin American and Caribbean States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 2003; and one member from African States, two members from Asian States, two members from Latin American and Caribbean States and six members from Western European and other States for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2003.

PERMANENT FORUM ON INDIGENOUS ISSUES

The Council elected Qin Xiaomei (China) for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 2004.

Nominations postponed from a previous session

COMMITTEE FOR PROGRAMME AND COORDINATION

The Council nominated SWITZERLAND for election by the General Assembly at its fifty-seventh session for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2003.

The Council further postponed the nomination of one member from Western European and other States for election by the General Assembly for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2003.

2002/302. Modalities for establishing an Ad Hoc Advisory Group on African Countries Emerging from Conflict: Guinea-Bissau

At its 42nd plenary meeting, on 4 October 2002, the Economic and Social Council decided to entrust the President of the Council with the holding of consultations regarding the modalities for establishing an Ad Hoc Advisory Group on African Countries Emerging from Conflict: Guinea-Bissau, under the terms of Council resolution 2002/1 of 15 July 2002.

2002/303. Termination of the work of the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources for Development

At its 44th plenary meeting, on 25 October 2002, the Economic and Social Council, taking into account the decision contained in paragraph 144 (e) of the Plan of Implementation of the World Summit on Sustainable Development ("Johannesburg Plan of Implementation"),⁸⁶ decided to terminate the work of the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources for
