Firstly, ICLEI expresses <u>full support to the New York communique of the Global</u> <u>Task Force</u> at this session that urges for enhanced engagement of and support to local and subnational governments in the global efforts on sustainability in the post2015 development agenda. We would like to congratulate and thank our sister organization UCLG in facilitating this united voice.

Secondly, ICLEI is happy to have this dialogue because <u>it fully responds to our</u> <u>call exactly one year ago announced at the 2013 Bonn Declaration of Mayors</u>, to develop new modalities of interaction for local and subnational governments in order to fulfill their role as governmental stakeholders, including involvement in agenda setting, consultation and implementation, as foreseen para.42 of the Rio+20 outcome document.

Thirdly, ICLEI remains committed to contribute in the <u>follow-up of this dialogue</u> with a view to advance on innovative ideas that were expressed on the way towards Rio+20 and in the numerous processes afterwards. These include, but not limited to, ideas such as creation of new and additional channels of dialogue such as Permanent Forum of Governmental Stakeholders, at the UN and UN Environment Assembly, announcement and full implementation of a UN Decade on Sustainable Urbanization, establishment of a broader alliance of Friends of Sustainable Cities at numerous fora, adoption of a stand-alone SDG on sustainable cities and human settlements, ensuring a strong synergy between
