

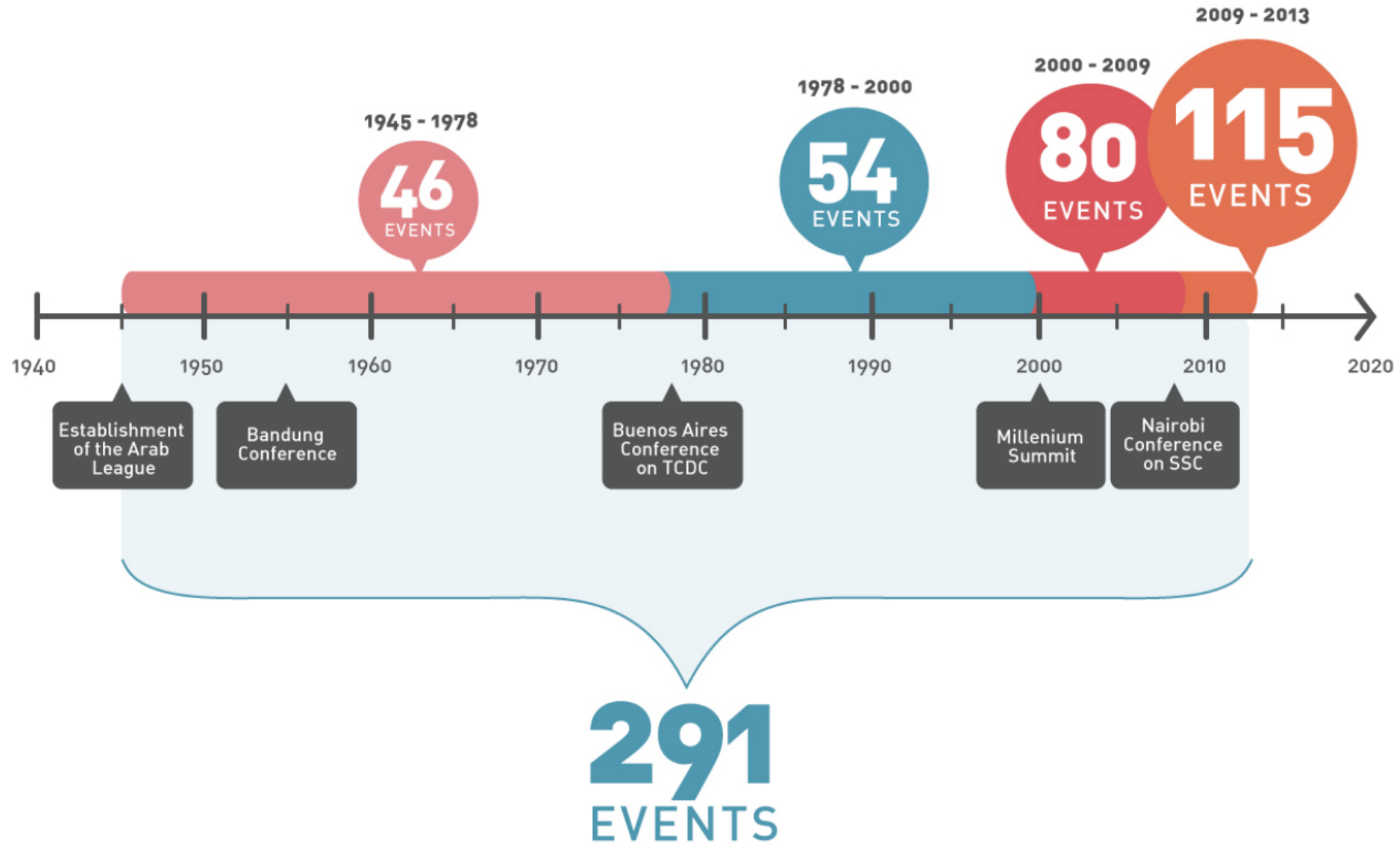

EVOLUTION OF SOUTH-SOUTH COOPERATION IN INTERNATIONAL POLITICAL ARENA



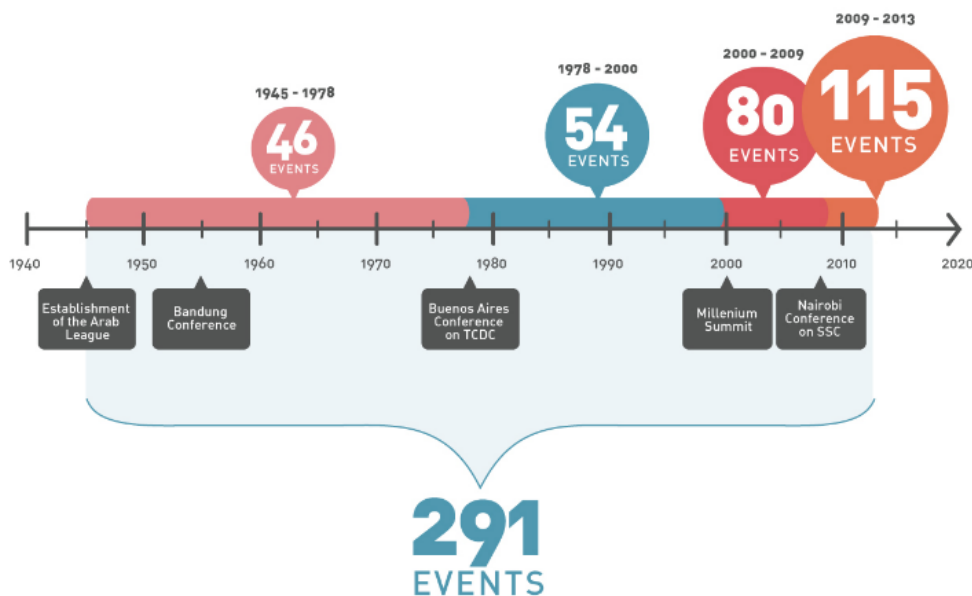
ESTIMATED GLOBAL FIGURES

DAC: ^{US\$}**12-14** or **9 to 10%** 2008
BILLION of global ODA

World Bank: ^{US\$}**12-15** or **10 to 12%** 2008
BILLION of traditional ODA

UNDESA: ^{US\$}**16.1-19** or **10%** 2011
BILLION of total development cooperation

EVOLUTION OF SOUTH-SOUTH COOPERATION IN INTERNATIONAL POLITICAL ARENA



ESTIMATED GLOBAL FIGURES

DAC:	US\$ 12-14 BILLION	or	9 to 10% of global ODA	2008
World Bank:	US\$ 12-15 BILLION	or	10 to 12% of traditional ODA	2008
UNDESA:	US\$ 16.1-19 BILLION	or	10% of total development cooperation	2011
