Mr. Chairman,
Distinguished Delegates,

I am pleased to introduce the Secretary-General's report on revised estimates resulting from resolutions and decisions adopted by the Economic and Social Council at its 2021 session; the report captures the budgetary impact on 2021 of resolutions and decisions adopted to date since the start of the 2021 session on 23 July 2020.

In particular, the report provides estimated resource requirements related to the Council's decision 2021/209, entitled "Date of the 2020 resumed session and dates and provisional agenda of the 2021 session of the Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations". The budgetary impact relating to that decision amounts to \$87,400 for 2021.

This amount is proposed for additional appropriation, as captured in section III of the report, and comprises non-post requirements amounting to \$78,000, under section 2, General Assembly and Economic and Social Council affairs and conference management, and \$9,400 under section 36, Staff assessment, of the proposed programme budget for 2021.
