Mr. Chairman,
Distinguished Delegates,

I have the honour to present the report of the Secretary-General, A/76/524/Add.1, on the Revised estimates resulting from resolutions and decisions adopted by the Human Rights Council at its thirty-third special session where the Council adopted resolution S-33/1, Situation of human rights in Ethiopia.

In support of the implementation of this resolution, the report requests an additional appropriation in the amount of \$2,824,900 under the proposed programme budget for 2022, representing a charge against the contingency fund, comprising \$34,800

under section 2, General Assembly and Economic and Social Council affairs and conference management and \$2,790,100 under section 24, Human rights.

An additional appropriation in the amount of \$230,200 under section 36, Staff assessment, of the proposed programme budget for 2022, to be offset by an equivalent amount under income section 1, Income from staff assessment, is also requested.
