MARIAN DINU OF ROMANIA ELECTED CHAIRMAN OF FIFTH COMMITTEE

Marian Dinu of Romania, who was today elected Chairman of the Fifth Committee (Administrative and Budgetary), has been Counsellor at his country's Embassy in Washington, D.C., since August.

From 1990 until his present appointment, Mr. Dinu served as First Secretary in Romania's Permanent Mission to the United Nations in New York. He was his country's Fifth Committee representative at the last four General Assembly sessions, and a member of its delegation to the Security Council from 1990 to 1991.

From 1986 to 1990, Mr. Dinu was Second Secretary in the International Organizations Department of Romania's Ministry of Foreign Affairs. He entered the foreign service in 1976 and held various posts in his country's embassy in Moscow between 1977 and 1985. Before that, he was a scientific researcher at the Institute of World Economy in Bucharest.

He graduated from the Academy of Economic Studies for Foreign Trade in Bucharest in 1971, and did post-graduate work in international economic relations in 1975.

Born on 8 September 1948 in Bucharest, Mr. Dinu is married and has two daughters.
