In accordance with paragraph 2 of the aforementioned resolution, I was mandated to convene, during the sixty-first session of the General Assembly, an ad hoc open-ended working group to consider the "Draft United Nations policy statement and draft United Nations comprehensive strategy on assistance and support to victims of sexual exploitation and abuse by United Nations staff and related personnel", contained in document A/60/877.

I have the honour to inform you that H.E. Ambassador Jorge Urbina, Permanent Representative of Costa Rica, has agreed to act as the Chairperson of the above-mentioned ad hoc open-ended Working Group.

Furthermore, in view of the issues touched on by the draft policy statement and draft comprehensive strategy, I would encourage the involvement of an array of experts in the work of the Working Group.
