I have the honour to refer to resolution 63/302 entitled “2010 high-level plenary meeting of the General Assembly”, adopted during the sixty-third session on 9 July 2009.

The General Assembly decided to convene in 2010, at the commencement of the sixty fifth session of the General Assembly, a high-level plenary meeting of the Assembly, with the participation of Heads of State and Government.

The Assembly also decided by this resolution to “hold consultations on the scope, modalities, format and organization of the high-level plenary meeting of the Assembly with a view to concluding consultations before the end of 2009 and, in this regard, requests the Secretary-General to submit a report to the Assembly at the beginning of its sixty fourth session.”

In accordance with resolution 63/302, the Secretary-General’s report is available as document A/64/263.

I am very pleased to inform you that His Excellency Mr. Carsten Staur, Permanent Representative of Denmark and His Excellency Mr. Paul Badji, Permanent Representative of Senegal, have agreed to serve as Co-Facilitators for the consultations.

To ensure a successful 2010 high-level plenary meeting with the participation of Heads of State and Government, I trust all Member States will give the Co-Facilitators their full support on this collective undertaking.

The first meeting to launch the consultations process will be held on Thursday, 15 October 2009.
