In accordance with General Assembly resolution 58/126 on the revitalization of the work of the General Assembly, the President-elect of the General Assembly is to suggest an issue, or issues, of global concern upon which Member States will be invited to comment during the general debate at the forthcoming session of the Assembly. As also stated in the resolution, such suggestions will be without prejudice to the sovereign right of Member States to solely and entirely determine the content of their general debate statements.

Following consultations, and as announced in my acceptance speech on 14 June, I have declared the theme of the 68th general debate to be "The Post-2015 Development Agenda: Setting the Stage!"

I would be grateful if your Excellency could circulate this letter to all Member States for their consideration.
