

Draft resolution on the four one-day structured dialogues on possible arrangements for a facilitation mechanism to promote the development, transfer and dissemination of clean and environmentally sound technology

PP1 Welcoming the convening of four structured dialogues on possible arrangements for a facilitation mechanism to promote the development, transfer and dissemination of clean and environmentally sound technology, on 29 and 30 April, 4 June and 23 July 2014, in accordance with General Assembly resolution 68/210 of December 2013,

PP2 Taking note of the summary prepared by the President of the 68th General Assembly of the discussions and recommendations emerging from the four one-day structured dialogues to consider possible arrangements for a facilitation mechanism to promote clean and environmentally sound technologies, held during the 68th session of the General Assembly.

PP3 Taking note of the views expressed and active participation of Member States and other stakeholders as well as experts and panelists during the dialogues,

OP1 Requests the President of the 69th General Assembly to continue consultations based on the above mentioned recommendations prepared by the President of the 68th General Assembly with the aim of reaching a conclusion during the 69th Session of the General Assembly in the context of the post-2015 development agenda.

OP2 Invites the Secretary-General to take into account the recommendations emerging from the structured dialogues on possible arrangements for a facilitation mechanism to promote the development, transfer and dissemination of clean and environmentally sound technologies, contained in the summary prepared by the President of the 68th General Assembly, when preparing his synthesis report.
