I refer to my letter of 25 September 2014, on the participation of non-governmental organizations and other stakeholders in the high-level meeting of the General Assembly on the twenty-fifth anniversary of the adoption of the Convention on the Rights of the Child, to be held on 20 November 2014.

By that letter, Member States were provided, for consideration on a non-objection basis, a list of representatives of non-governmental organizations accredited to or in a collaborative relationship or partnership with the United Nations Children's Fund, as well as other relevant non-governmental organizations, civil society organizations, academic institutions and the private sector who may participate in the high-level meeting, in accordance with Operative Paragraph 8 of General Assembly resolution 68/273.

As my Office has received an objection from certain Member States prior to the deadline set in the aforementioned letter, a revised list is now being circulated for the attention of the General Assembly.
