Excellency,

I have the pleasure to inform you that the Co-Facilitators of the intergovernmental negotiations on the post-2015 development agenda, H.E. David Donoghue, Permanent Representative of Ireland, and H.E. Macharia Kamau, Permanent Representative of Kenya, have confirmed that agreement has been reached on the themes for the six interactive dialogues during the United Nations Summit for the adoption of the post-2015 development agenda, scheduled for 25-27 September 2015. The themes are attached.

In accordance with General Assembly resolution 69/244, the six dialogues will be co-chaired by two Heads of State or Government selected by their respective regional groups. I will shortly be requesting the Chairs of the regional groups to coordinate the selection of the co-chairs with a view to finalizing this process by June 19, 2015.
