Excellency,

I refer to the letter of 27 July, 2015, sent by H.E. Mr. Sam Kutesa, President of the 69th Session of the General Assembly, in accordance with General Assembly resolution 69/244, regarding the six Interactive Dialogues to be held during the Summit for the adoption of the Post-2015 Development Agenda. This letter requested that you notify the Secretariat, by 15 August, in which of the six Interactive Dialogues your Head of your delegation would like to participate and deliver remarks.

In a subsequent letter, dated 31 August, you were provided with the list of Co-chairs for the Interactive Dialogues, and you were informed of the adjustment to the timing of the Interactive Dialogue on Climate Change from Saturday, 26 September to Sunday, 27 September.

Participation in the Interactive Dialogues will be determined on a first-come-first-served basis, ensuring equitable geographical distribution and allowing for some flexibility. Member States are encouraged to be represented at the Interactive Dialogues at the level of Head of State or Government.

It is envisaged that up to thirty-three Member States, five observers and ten other speakers, including representatives of the United Nations system, civil society, the private sector and other stakeholders can be accommodated in each Interactive Dialogue. The list of participants in each Interactive Dialogue will be made available prior to each meeting.

In order to finalize the list of participants for each of the Interactive Dialogues, I kindly request that you communicate your delegation's preference to the Secretariat by Monday 21 September, 2015.
