It is my honor to address you in your capacity as the Co-Chairs of the Intergovernmental Negotiations on the question of equitable representations on and increase in the membership of the Security Council and other related matters to the Security Council (IGN) of the 78th United Nations General Assembly.

The IGN meeting on 19 March 2024, which focused on the working methods of the Security Council, was a fruitful one. To build on the discussion, and increase awareness of recent developments in the Council's working methods, I believe that the UN website "Interactive Handbook of the Working Methods of the Security Council" (<u>https://www.un.org/securitycouncil/content/interactive-handbook</u>) will be a useful source of information for Member States' reference. This website, sponsored by Japan and developed together with the Secretariat and several former Council members, is a web-based format of the "Green Handbook", which compiles the Provisional Rules of Procedure of the Security Council (S/96/Rev.7), Note 507 (S/2017/507), and all subsequent notes by the President issued in relation to the working methods of the Council, and provides easy access to those documents. It would be appreciated if you could upload the above link to the Security Council reform repository website.

We look forward to continuing a constructive discussion at the IGN for an early reform of the Council to better reflect the 21st Century.
