

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE SIXTH COMMITTEE eROOM

The Sixth Committee eRoom is an in-session electronic tool for exclusive use by delegates of Member States.

Access for delegates who already have un.int email addresses

Delegates who already have a un.int email address may submit a request for access via their un.int email to 6thcommittee@un.org, indicating their un.int username. They will subsequently have access to the eRoom with their individual un.int username and password.

Delegates may follow the same procedure to obtain use of the eRoom through their respective Permanent Missions' un.int email addresses, in the absence of individual addresses. In such case, delegates should make internal arrangements for obtaining usernames and passwords and receiving email alerts.

Access for delegates who do not have un.int email addresses

For delegates who do not have a un.int email address, the Secretariat of the Sixth Committee may provide a temporary username and password for access to the eRoom. Interested delegates are invited to send a request for a temporary login in writing and on the official letterhead of their Mission. These requests could be sent via email to 6thcommittee@un.org or by fax to 1-212-963-1963.

Delegates may request un.int email addresses through Mission Support. Requests should be submitted in writing and on the official letterhead of the requestor's Mission (please specify that the request is for the purpose of registration for the Sixth Committee eRoom).
