Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

The United States, as always, is proud to serve as host country to the United Nations. The United States takes its role as host country seriously, and it takes all of its obligations under the Headquarters Agreement seriously as well. We believe that the Committee on Relations with the Host Country is a valuable forum in which to discuss relevant issues relating to this large, diverse, and dynamic diplomatic community in New York. The Committee's meetings provide the host country with an opportunity to address the concerns of the UN's diplomatic community.

The host country greatly values the cooperation and the constructive spirit of the Committee in its work. We also appreciate the interest and participation of numerous observer delegations in the Committee's meetings.
