Consideration of Effective Measures to Enhance the Protection, Security and Safety of Diplomatic and Consular Missions and Representatives

Mr. Chairperson,

The inviolability of diplomatic and consular missions and the special duty to protect

them is one of the cornerstones of international relations. Israel thanks the Secretary

General for his latest report and for his commitment to developing effective measures

to enhance the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and

representatives.

Terrorism is an ever-present threat from which no one is immune. Israeli missions and

diplomats have long since been targets of terrorist attacks, including State-sponsored

terror activity. Regrettably, Israeli diplomats continue to be targeted by such heinous

plots around the world.

Israel strongly believes that the international nature of these hateful crimes requires an

effective and resolute international response. We call upon the international

community to cooperate closely on the operational and legal levels and with regards

to intelligence sharing, in order to provide the utmost protection for all diplomatic and

consular missions and representatives. We also urge Member States to strongly

condemn and take necessary action against States that support terror attacks against

diplomatic and consular missions and representatives.

Israel refers to the commitment of receiving States under the Vienna Convention on

Diplomatic Relations of 1961, the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 1963,

and all other relevant instruments of international law providing protection for

diplomatic and consular missions and representatives.

We urge the international community as a whole, to cooperate closely to ensure a safe international environment, which will allow diplomatic and consular missions and representatives to carry out their essential duties safely and accomplish their official tasks in an environment that is free from any outside threat.
