The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Serbia to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to the latter's Note No. LA/COD/50 of 6 December 2007 has the honour to inform that citizens of the Republic of Serbia who, while serving as United Nations officials or experts on mission, commit a criminal offence punishable by the laws of the Republic of Serbia are accountable before a Serbian court of law. The laws of the Republic of Serbia, however, do not provide penalties for United Nations officials and experts on mission who are alleged to have committed crimes of a serious nature and the Republic of Serbia is not in possession of any information at this moment as would be relevant for the exchange under paragraph 4 of UNGA resolution 62/63 and would facilitate the conduct of investigations and prosecution of United Nations officials or experts.

No citizen of the Republic of Serbia, while serving as United Nations official or expert on mission, has so far committed a criminal offence punishable by the Serbian laws.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Serbia avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretary-General of the United Nations the assurances of its highest consideration.
